Subject: Bill Brief on HB 2695

House Bill 2695 allows certain employees of the department of corrections to attend courses at the Kansas law enforcement training center.

New Section 1 would allow the secretary of corrections, with the consent of the director of police training at the law enforcement training center, to designate an employee other than a special agent to attend the law enforcement training center or any training school certified pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5604a or to attend courses provided by the training center or training schools. The employee and the department would be required to receive a transcript of the courses successfully completed by the employee.

Section 2 amends K.S.A. 74-5602 to include special agents of the department of corrections in the definition of a police officer or law enforcement officer for the purposes of the Kansas law enforcement training act.
