SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2723 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2723 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2723 would define “medical oversight” as the review, approval, and implementation of medical protocols as well as the approval and monitoring of activities, competency, and education of emergency medical service providers. The bill would shift the responsibility of medical protocol approval to a medical director designated by an operator. Current law requires this approval from either a county medical society, or medical staff of a hospital to which the ambulance service primarily transports, or if either of those are unable or unavailable the medical advisory council of the Emergency Medical Services Board.

HB 2723 would have no fiscal effect.
