**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 306 by Senate Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 306 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 306 would exempt state odometer reading recording requirements when those requirements are exempted by federal law. The bill would take effect from and after January 1, 2021, and its publication in the statute book.

The Department of Revenue estimates additional State General Fund expenditures of \$13,650 in FY 2021 if the bill is enacted. The additional expenditures would be for changes to the agency's information technology equipment and systems to comply with the requirements of the bill. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 306 is not reflected in *The FY 2021 Governor's Budget Report*.
