1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to electric-assisted scooters;
2 definitions; requirements; penalty; amending K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-126,
3 8-128, 8-197, 8-1486 and 8-2118 and repealing the existing sections.
4

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 New Section 1. "Electric-assisted scooter" means every self-propelled
7 vehicle that has at least two wheels in contact with the ground, an electric
8 motor, handlebars, a brake and a deck that is designed to be stood upon
9 when riding.

10 New Sec. 2. (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate an
11 electric-assisted scooter: (1) On any interstate highway, federal highway or
12 state highway; or (2) on any public highway or street within the corporate
13 limits of any city unless authorized by such city.

14 (b) The provisions of subsection (a) shall not prohibit an electric-
15 assisted scooter from crossing a federal or state highway.

16 (c) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the uniform act
17 regulating traffic on highways.

18 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-126 is hereby amended to read as
19 follows: 8-126. The following words and phrases when used in this act
20 shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them herein:

21 (a) "All-terrain vehicle" means any motorized nonhighway vehicle 50
22 inches or less in width, having a dry weight of 1,500 pounds or less,
23 traveling on three or more nonhighway tires.

24 (b) "Autocycle" means a three-wheel motorcycle that has a steering
25 wheel and seating that does not require the operator to straddle or sit
26 astride it.

27 (c) "Commission" or "state highway commission" means the director
28 of vehicles of the department of revenue.

29 (d) "Contractor" means a person, partnership, corporation, local
30 government, county government, county treasurer or other state agency
31 that has contracted with the department to provide services associated with
32 vehicle functions.

33 (e) "Department" or "motor vehicle department" or "vehicle
34 department" means the division of vehicles of the department of revenue,
35 acting directly or through its duly authorized officers and agents. When
36 acting on behalf of the department of revenue pursuant to this act, a county

1 treasurer shall be deemed to be an agent of the state of Kansas.

2 (f) "Division" means the division of vehicles of the department of
3 revenue.

4 (g) *"Electric-assisted scooter" means every self-propelled vehicle*
5 *that has at least two wheels in contact with the ground, an electric motor,*
6 *handlebars, a brake and a deck that is designed to be stood upon when*
7 *riding.*

8 ~~(g)~~(h) "Electric personal assistive mobility device" means a self-
9 balancing two nontandem wheeled device, designed to transport only one
10 person, with an electric propulsion system that limits the maximum speed
11 of the device to 15 miles per hour or less.

12 ~~(h)~~(i) "Electric vehicle" means a vehicle that is powered by an
13 electric motor drawing current from rechargeable storage batteries or other
14 portable electrical energy storage devices, provided the recharge energy
15 must be drawn from a source off the vehicle, such as, but not limited to:

16 (1) Residential electric service;

17 (2) an electric vehicle charging station, also called an EV charging
18 station, an electric recharging point, a charging point, EVSE (Electric
19 Vehicle Supply Equipment) or a public charging station.

20 ~~(i)~~(j) "Electronic certificate of title" means any electronic record of
21 ownership, including any lien or liens that may be recorded, retained by
22 the division in accordance with K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-135d, and
23 amendments thereto.

24 ~~(j)~~(k) "Electronic notice of security interest" means the division's
25 online internet program ~~which~~ that enables a dealer or secured party to
26 submit a notice of security interest as defined in this section, and to cancel
27 the notice or release the security interest using the program. This program
28 is also known as the Kansas elien or KSelien.

29 ~~(k)~~(l) "Farm tractor" means every motor vehicle designed and used as
30 a farm implement power unit operated with or without other attached farm
31 implements in any manner consistent with the structural design of such
32 power unit.

33 ~~(l)~~(m) "Farm trailer" means every trailer and semitrailer as those
34 terms are defined in this section, designed and used primarily as a farm
35 vehicle.

36 ~~(m)~~(n) "Foreign vehicle" means every motor vehicle, trailer, or
37 semitrailer ~~which~~ that shall be brought into this state otherwise than in
38 ordinary course of business by or through a manufacturer or dealer and
39 ~~which~~ has not been registered in this state.

40 ~~(n)~~(o) "Golf cart" means a motor vehicle that has not less than three
41 wheels in contact with the ground, an unladen weight of not more than
42 1,800 pounds, is designed to be and is operated at not more than 25 miles
43 per hour and is designed to carry not more than four persons including the

1 driver.

2 ~~(p)~~ "Highway" means every way or place of whatever nature open
3 to the use of the public as a matter of right for the purpose of vehicular
4 travel. The term "highway" shall not be deemed to include a roadway or
5 driveway upon grounds owned by private owners, colleges, universities or
6 other institutions.

7 ~~(q)~~ "Implement of husbandry" means every vehicle designed or
8 adapted and used exclusively for agricultural operations, including
9 feedlots, and only incidentally moved or operated upon the highways.
10 Such term shall include, but not be limited to:

11 (1) A farm tractor;

12 (2) a self-propelled farm implement;

13 (3) a fertilizer spreader, nurse tank or truck permanently mounted
14 with a spreader used exclusively for dispensing or spreading water, dust or
15 liquid fertilizers or agricultural chemicals, as defined in K.S.A. 2-2202,
16 and amendments thereto, regardless of ownership;

17 (4) a truck mounted with a fertilizer spreader used or manufactured
18 principally to spread animal dung;

19 (5) a mixer-feed truck owned and used by a feedlot, as defined in
20 K.S.A. 47-1501, and amendments thereto, and specially designed and used
21 exclusively for dispensing food to livestock in such feedlot.

22 ~~(r)~~ "Lien" means a security interest as defined in this section.

23 ~~(s)~~ "Lightweight roadable vehicle" means a multipurpose motor
24 vehicle that is allowed to be driven on public roadways and is required to
25 be registered with, and flown under the direction of, the federal aviation
26 administration.

27 ~~(t)~~ "Manufacturer" means every person engaged in the business of
28 manufacturing motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers.

29 ~~(u)~~ "Micro utility truck" means any motor vehicle ~~which~~ that is not
30 less than 48 inches in width, has an overall length, including the bumper,
31 of not more than 160 inches, has an unladen weight, including fuel and
32 fluids, of more than 1,500 pounds, can exceed 40 miles per hour as
33 originally manufactured and is manufactured with a metal cab. "Micro
34 utility truck" does not include a work-site utility vehicle or recreational
35 off-highway vehicle.

36 ~~(v)~~ "Motor vehicle" means every vehicle, other than a motorized
37 bicycle or a motorized wheelchair, ~~which~~ that is self-propelled.

38 ~~(w)~~ "Motorcycle" means every motor vehicle, including
39 autcycles, designed to travel on not more than three wheels in contact
40 with the ground, except any such vehicle as may be included within the
41 term "tractor" as defined in this section.

42 ~~(x)~~ "Motorized bicycle" means every device having two tandem
43 wheels or three wheels, ~~which~~ that may be propelled by either human

1 power or helper motor, or by both, and ~~which~~ has:

- 2 (1) A motor which produces not more than 3.5 brake horsepower;
- 3 (2) a cylinder capacity of not more than 130 cubic centimeters;
- 4 (3) an automatic transmission; and
- 5 (4) the capability of a maximum design speed of no more than 30
- 6 miles per hour.

7 ~~(x)~~(y) "Motorized wheelchair" means any self-propelled vehicle
8 designed specifically for use by a physically disabled person and such
9 vehicle is incapable of a speed in excess of 15 miles per hour.

10 ~~(y)~~(z) "New vehicle dealer" means every person actively engaged in
11 the business of buying, selling or exchanging new motor vehicles, travel
12 trailers, trailers or vehicles and who holds a dealer's contract therefor from
13 a manufacturer or distributor and who has an established place of business
14 in this state.

15 ~~(z)~~(aa) "Nonresident" means every person who is not a resident of
16 this state.

17 ~~(aa)~~(bb) "Notice of security interest" means a notification to the
18 division from a dealer or secured party of a purchase money security
19 interest as provided in article 9 of chapter 84 of the Kansas Statutes
20 Annotated, and amendments thereto, upon a vehicle ~~which~~ that has been
21 sold and delivered to the purchaser describing the vehicle and showing the
22 name, address and acknowledgment of the secured party as well as the
23 name and address of the debtor or debtors and other information the
24 division requires.

25 ~~(bb)~~(cc) "Oil well servicing, oil well clean-out or oil well drilling
26 machinery or equipment" means a vehicle constructed as a machine used
27 exclusively for servicing, cleaning-out or drilling an oil well and
28 consisting in general of a mast, an engine for power, a draw works and a
29 chassis permanently constructed or assembled for one or more of those
30 purposes. The passenger capacity of the cab of a vehicle shall not be
31 considered in determining whether such vehicle is oil well servicing, oil
32 well clean-out or oil well drilling machinery or equipment.

33 ~~(ee)~~(dd) "Owner" means a person who holds the legal title of a
34 vehicle, or in the event a vehicle is the subject of an agreement for the
35 conditional sale thereof with the right of purchase upon performance of the
36 conditions stated in the agreement and with an immediate right of
37 possession vested in the conditional vendee or in the event a vehicle is
38 subject to a lease of 30 days or more with an immediate right of possession
39 vested in the lessee; or in the event a party having a security interest in a
40 vehicle is entitled to possession, then such conditional vendee or lessee or
41 secured party shall be deemed the owner for the purpose of this act.

42 ~~(dd)~~(ee) "Passenger vehicle" means every motor vehicle, as defined
43 in this section, ~~which~~ that is designed primarily to carry 10 or fewer

1 passengers, and ~~which~~ is not used as a truck.

2 ~~(ee)~~(ff) "Person" means every natural person, firm, partnership,
3 association or corporation.

4 ~~(ff)~~(gg) "Pole trailer" means any two-wheel vehicle used as a trailer
5 with bolsters that support the load, and do not have a rack or body
6 extending to the tractor drawing the load.

7 ~~(gg)~~(hh) "Recreational off-highway vehicle" means any motor vehicle
8 more than 50 but not greater than 64 inches in width, having a dry weight
9 of 2,000 pounds or less, traveling on four or more nonhighway tires.

10 ~~(hh)~~(ii) "Road tractor" means every motor vehicle designed and used
11 for drawing other vehicles, and not so constructed as to carry any load
12 thereon independently, or any part of the weight of a vehicle or load so
13 drawn.

14 ~~(ii)~~(jj) "Self-propelled farm implement" means every farm implement
15 designed for specific use applications with its motive power unit
16 permanently incorporated in its structural design.

17 ~~(jj)~~(kk) "Semitrailer" means every vehicle of the trailer type so
18 designed and used in conjunction with a motor vehicle that some part of its
19 own weight and that of its own load rests upon or is carried by another
20 vehicle.

21 ~~(kk)~~(ll) "Specially constructed vehicle" means any vehicle ~~which that~~
22 shall not have been originally constructed under a distinctive name, make,
23 model or type, or ~~which that~~, if originally otherwise constructed shall have
24 been materially altered by the removal of essential parts, or by the addition
25 or substitution of essential parts, new or used, derived from other vehicles
26 or makes of vehicles.

27 ~~(ll)~~(mm) "Trailer" means every vehicle without motive power
28 designed to carry property or passengers wholly on its own structure and
29 to be drawn by a motor vehicle.

30 ~~(mm)~~(nn) "Travel trailer" means every vehicle without motive power
31 designed to be towed by a motor vehicle constructed primarily for
32 recreational purposes.

33 ~~(nn)~~(oo) "Truck" means a motor vehicle ~~which that~~ is used for the
34 transportation or delivery of freight and merchandise or more than 10
35 passengers.

36 ~~(oo)~~(pp) "Truck tractor" means every motor vehicle designed and
37 used primarily for drawing other vehicles, and not so constructed as to
38 carry a load other than a part of the weight of the vehicle or load so drawn.

39 ~~(pp)~~(qq) "Used vehicle dealer" means every person actively engaged
40 in the business of buying, selling or exchanging used vehicles, and having
41 an established place of business in this state and who does not hold a
42 dealer's contract for the sale of new motor vehicles, travel trailers or
43 vehicles.

1 ~~(qq)~~(rr) "Vehicle" means every device in, upon or by which any
 2 person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a public
 3 highway, excepting electric personal assistive mobility devices or devices
 4 moved by human power or used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.

5 ~~(rr)~~(ss) "Vehicle functions" means services relating to the application,
 6 processing, auditing or distribution of original or renewal vehicle
 7 registrations, certificates of title, driver's licenses and division-issued
 8 identification cards associated with services and functions set out in
 9 articles 1, 2 and 13 of chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and
 10 amendments thereto. "Vehicle functions" may also include personal
 11 property taxation duties set out in article 51 of chapter 79 of the Kansas
 12 Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, and other vehicle-related
 13 events described in article 1 of chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated,
 14 and amendments thereto.

15 ~~(ss)~~(tt) "Work-site utility vehicle" means any motor vehicle ~~which~~
 16 *that* is not less than 48 inches in width, has an unladen weight, including
 17 fuel and fluids, of more than 800 pounds and is equipped with four or
 18 more nonhighway tires, a steering wheel and bench or bucket-type seating
 19 allowing at least two people to sit side-by-side, and may be equipped with
 20 a bed or cargo box for hauling materials. "Work-site utility vehicle" does
 21 not include a micro utility truck or recreational off-highway vehicle.

22 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-128 is hereby amended to read as
 23 follows: 8-128. (a) The following need not be registered under this act,
 24 any:

- 25 (1) Implement of husbandry;
- 26 (2) all-terrain vehicle;
- 27 (3) micro utility truck;
- 28 (4) golf cart;
- 29 (5) work-site utility vehicle;
- 30 (6) road roller or road machinery temporarily operated or moved
 31 upon the highways;
- 32 (7) municipally owned fire truck;
- 33 (8) privately owned fire truck subject to a mutual aid agreement with
 34 a municipality;
- 35 (9) school bus owned and operated by a school district or a nonpublic
 36 school ~~which~~ *that* has the name of the municipality, school district or
 37 nonpublic school plainly painted thereon;
- 38 (10) farm trailer used in carrying not more than 6,000 pounds owned
 39 by a person engaged in farming, which trailer is used exclusively by the
 40 owner to transport agricultural products produced by such owner or
 41 commodities purchased by the owner for use on the farm owned or rented
 42 by the owner of such trailer and the weight of any such farm trailer, plus
 43 the cargo weight of 6,000 pounds or less, shall not be considered in

1 determining the gross weight for which the truck or truck tractor
2 propelling the same shall be registered; ~~or~~

3 (11) farm trailer used and designed for transporting hay or forage
4 from a field to a storage area or from a storage area to a feedlot, ~~which~~
5 *that* is only incidentally moved or operated upon the highways, except that
6 this paragraph shall not apply to a farm semitrailer; *or*

7 (12) *electric-assisted scooter.*

8 (b) Self-propelled cranes where the crane operator on a job site
9 operates the controls of such crane from a permanent housing or module
10 on the crane and the crane is not used for the transportation of property,
11 except the property that is required for the operation of the crane itself and
12 earth moving equipment ~~which~~ *that* are equipped with pneumatic tires may
13 be moved on the highways of this state from one job location to another, or
14 to or from places of storage, delivery or repair, without complying with the
15 provisions of the law relating to registration and display of license plates
16 but shall comply with all the other requirements of the law relating to
17 motor vehicles.

18 (c) Oil well servicing, oil well clean-out or oil well drilling machinery
19 or equipment need not be registered under this act but shall comply with
20 all the other requirements of the law relating to motor vehicles.

21 (d) A truck permanently mounted with a hydraulic concrete pump and
22 placing boom may be moved on the highways of this state from one job
23 location to another, or to or from places of storage delivery or repair,
24 without being registered under this act, but shall comply with all the other
25 requirements of the law relating to motor vehicles. The provisions of this
26 subsection shall not apply to ready-mix concrete trucks.

27 Sec. 5. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-197 is hereby amended to read as
28 follows: 8-197. (a) The provisions of K.S.A. 8-197 ~~to~~ *through* 8-199,
29 ~~inclusive~~, and amendments thereto, shall be a part of and supplemental to
30 the provisions of article 1 of chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated,
31 and amendments thereto, and as used in such sections, the words and
32 phrases defined by K.S.A. 8-126, and amendments thereto, shall have the
33 meanings respectively ascribed to them therein.

34 (b) As used in K.S.A. 8-197 through 8-199, and amendments thereto:

35 (1) (A) "Nonhighway vehicle" means:

36 (i) Any motor vehicle ~~which~~ *that* cannot be registered because it is
37 not manufactured for the purpose of using the same on the highways of
38 this state and is not provided with the equipment required by state statute
39 for vehicles of such type ~~which~~ *that* are used on the highways of this state;

40 (ii) any motor vehicle, other than a salvage vehicle, for which the
41 owner has not provided motor vehicle liability insurance coverage or an
42 approved self insurance plan under K.S.A. 40-3104, and amendments
43 thereto, and has not applied for or obtained registration of such motor

1 vehicle in accordance with article 1 of chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes
2 Annotated, and amendments thereto;

3 (iii) any all-terrain vehicle;

4 (iv) any work-site utility vehicle;

5 (v) any micro utility truck;

6 (vi) recreational off-highway vehicle; ~~or~~

7 (vii) any travel trailer ~~which that~~ cannot be registered because it is not
8 manufactured for the purpose of using the travel trailer on the highways of
9 this state and is not provided with the equipment by state statute for travel
10 trailers ~~which that~~ are used on the highways of this state; *or*

11 (viii) any electric-assisted scooter; and

12 (B) "nonhighway vehicle" shall not include an implement of
13 husbandry, as defined in K.S.A. 8-126, and amendments thereto.

14 (2) "Salvage vehicle" means:

15 (A) Any motor vehicle, other than a late model vehicle, ~~which that~~ is
16 of a type required to be registered in this state, but ~~which that~~ cannot be
17 registered because it has been wrecked or damaged to the extent that: The
18 equipment required by state statute on any such vehicle used on the
19 highways of this state is not present or is not in good condition or proper
20 adjustment, as prescribed by state statute or any rules and regulations
21 adopted pursuant thereto, or such vehicle is in an inoperable condition or a
22 condition that would render the operation thereof on the highways of this
23 state a hazard to the public safety; and in either event, such vehicle would
24 require substantial repairs to rebuild or restore such vehicle to a condition
25 ~~which that~~ will permit the registration thereof;

26 (B) a late model vehicle ~~which that~~ is of a type required to be
27 registered in this state and ~~which~~ has been wrecked or damaged to the
28 extent that the total cost of repair is 75% or more of the fair market value
29 of the motor vehicle immediately preceding the time it was wrecked or
30 damaged and such condition was not merely exterior cosmetic damage to
31 such vehicle as a result of windstorm or hail;

32 (C) a motor vehicle, ~~which that~~ is of a type required to be registered
33 in this state that the insurer determines is a total loss and for which the
34 insurer takes title; or

35 (D) a travel trailer ~~which that~~ is of a type required to be registered in
36 this state, but ~~which~~ cannot be registered because it has been wrecked or
37 damaged to the extent that: (i) The equipment required by state statute on
38 any such travel trailer used on the highways of this state is not present or is
39 not in good condition or proper adjustment, as prescribed by state statute
40 or any rules and regulations; or (ii) such travel trailer is in an inoperable
41 condition or a condition that would render the operation on the highways
42 of this state a hazard to the public safety; and in either event, such travel
43 trailer would require substantial repairs to rebuild or restore to a condition

1 ~~which~~ *that* will permit the registration of the travel trailer;

2 (3) "salvage title" means a certificate of title issued by the division
3 designating a motor vehicle or travel trailer a salvage vehicle;

4 (4) "rebuilt salvage vehicle" means any motor vehicle or travel trailer
5 previously issued a salvage title;

6 (5) "rebuilt salvage title" means a certificate of title issued by the
7 division for a vehicle previously designated a salvage vehicle ~~which~~ *that* is
8 now designated a rebuilt salvage vehicle;

9 (6) "late model vehicle" means any motor vehicle which has a
10 manufacturer's model year designation of or later than the year in ~~which~~
11 *that* the vehicle was wrecked or damaged or any of the six preceding
12 years;

13 (7) "fair market value" means the retail value of a motor vehicle as:

14 (A) Set forth in a current edition of any nationally recognized
15 compilation, including an automated database of retail value; or

16 (B) determined pursuant to a market survey of comparable vehicles
17 with regard to condition and equipment; and

18 (8) "cost of repairs" means the estimated or actual retail cost of parts
19 needed to repair a vehicle plus the cost of labor computed by using the
20 hourly labor rate and time allocations for automobile repairs that are
21 customary and reasonable. Retail costs of parts and labor rates may be
22 based upon collision estimating manuals or electronic computer estimating
23 systems customarily used in the automobile industry. The total cost of
24 repairs to rebuild or reconstruct the vehicle shall not include the cost of
25 repairing, replacing or reinstalling tires, sound systems, or any sales tax on
26 parts or materials to rebuild or reconstruct the vehicle.

27 Sec. 6. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-1486 is hereby amended to read as
28 follows: 8-1486. K.S.A. 8-1402a, 8-1414a, 8-1439c, 8-1458a, 8-1459a, 8-
29 1475a, 8-1487, 8-1488, 8-1489 and 8-1490, and amendments thereto, and
30 K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-1491, 8-1492, 8-1493, 8-1494, 8-1495, 8-1496 ~~and~~,
31 8-1497 *and section 1*, and amendments thereto, shall be a part of, and
32 supplemental to, the uniform act regulating traffic on highways.

33 Sec. 7. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-2118 is hereby amended to read as
34 follows: 8-2118.(a) A person charged with a traffic infraction shall, except
35 as provided in subsection (b), appear at the place and time specified in the
36 notice to appear. If the person enters an appearance, waives right to trial,
37 pleads guilty or no contest, the fine shall be no greater than that specified
38 in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs shall be
39 taxed as provided by law.

40 (b) Prior to the time specified in the notice to appear, a person
41 charged with a traffic infraction may enter a written appearance, waive
42 right to trial, plead guilty or no contest and pay the fine for the violation as
43 specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs

1 provided by law. Payment may be made in any manner accepted by the
 2 court. The traffic citation shall not have been complied with if the payment
 3 is not honored for any reason, or if the fine and court costs are not paid in
 4 full. When a person charged with a traffic infraction makes payment
 5 without executing a written waiver of right to trial and plea of guilty or no
 6 contest, the payment shall be deemed such an appearance, waiver of right
 7 to trial and plea of no contest.

8 (c) The following uniform fine schedule shall apply uniformly
 9 throughout the state but shall not limit the fine ~~which~~ *that* may be imposed
 10 following a court appearance, except an appearance made for the purpose
 11 of pleading and payment as permitted by subsection (a). The description of
 12 offense contained in the following uniform fine schedule is for reference
 13 only and is not a legal definition.

18 (d) Traffic offenses classified as traffic infractions by this section
 19 shall be classified as ordinance traffic infractions by those cities adopting
 20 ordinances prohibiting the same offenses. A schedule of fines for all
 21 ordinance traffic infractions shall be established by the municipal judge in
 22 the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-4305, and amendments thereto. Such
 23 fines may vary from those contained in the uniform fine schedule
 24 contained in subsection (c).

25 (e) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
 26 (c) shall be doubled if a person is convicted of a traffic infraction, which is
 27 defined as a moving violation in accordance with rules and regulations
 28 adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 8-249, and amendments thereto, committed
 29 within any road construction zone as defined in K.S.A. 8-1458a, and
 30 amendments thereto.

31 (f) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and
 32 amendments thereto, within two years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-
 33 1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction
 34 shall be fined 1½ times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of
 35 the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
 36 (c). For a third violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments
 37 thereto, within two years, after two prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or
 38 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be
 39 fined two times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the
 40 schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c).
 41 For a fourth and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909,
 42 and amendments thereto, within two years after three prior convictions of
 43 K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon

1 conviction shall be fined 2½ times the applicable amount from one, but not
2 both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in
3 subsection (c).

4 (g) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
5 (c) relating to exceeding the maximum speed limit, shall be doubled if a
6 person is convicted of exceeding the maximum speed limit in a school
7 zone authorized under K.S.A. 8-1560(a)(4), and amendments thereto.

8 (h) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto,
9 within five years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-1556, and
10 amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction, shall be fined \$750 for
11 the second violation. For a third and each succeeding violation of K.S.A.
12 8-1556, and amendments thereto, within five years after two prior
13 convictions of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, such person, upon
14 conviction, shall be fined \$1,000 for the third and each succeeding
15 violation.
