

## Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 1615

By Senators Wagle, Denning and Hensley

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION relating to the adjournment of the  
2 senate and the house of representatives for a period during the 2020  
3 regular session of the legislature; extending such session beyond 90  
4 calendar days.

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6 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Kansas, the House of*  
7 *Representatives concurring therein:* That the 2020 regular session of  
8 the legislature shall be extended beyond 90 calendar days; and

9 *Be it further resolved:* Except as otherwise provided by the provisions of  
10 this concurrent resolution or other legislative action, that the  
11 legislature shall adjourn at the close of business of the daily session  
12 convened on March 19, 2020, and except as otherwise provided  
13 herein, shall reconvene on April 27, 2020, pursuant to adjournment of  
14 the daily session convened on March 19, 2020; and

15 *Be it further resolved:* That the second house bill consideration deadline  
16 established in 2019 Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 1603, Joint  
17 Rule 4(f), for the 2020 regular session is hereby extended to May 1,  
18 2020; and the bill consideration deadline established in 2019 Senate  
19 Concurrent Resolution No. 1603, Joint Rule 4(k), for the 2020 regular  
20 session is hereby extended to May 8, 2020; and

21 *Be it further resolved:* That if the legislative coordinating council  
22 determines it is necessary to secure the health and safety of the public,  
23 legislative staff and legislators, the legislative coordinating council  
24 may reconvene the legislature before April 27, 2020, or may postpone  
25 the reconvening of the legislature past April 27, 2020, by a majority  
26 vote of five members of the legislative coordinating council, except  
27 that such postponement shall not be later than May 21, 2020; and

28 *Be it further resolved:* That the legislature may adjourn and reconvene at  
29 any time during the period on and after April 27, 2020, or such other  
30 date on which the legislature reconvenes as determined by the  
31 legislative coordinating council, to May 21, 2020, but the legislature  
32 shall reconvene on May 21, 2020, at which time the legislature shall  
33 continue in session and shall adjourn sine die at the close of business  
34 of the daily session convened on May 21, 2020; and

35 *Be it further resolved:* That the secretary of the senate and the chief clerk  
36 of the house of representatives and employees specified by the

1 director of legislative administrative services for such purpose shall  
2 attend to their duties each day during such period of adjournment,  
3 Sundays excepted, for the purpose of receiving messages from the  
4 governor and conducting such other business as may be required; and

5 *Be it further resolved:* That members of the legislature shall not receive  
6 the per diem compensation and subsistence allowances provided for in  
7 K.S.A. 46-137a(a) and (b), and amendments thereto, for any day  
8 within a period in which both houses of the legislature are adjourned  
9 for more than two days, Sundays excepted; and

10 *Be it further resolved:* That members of the legislature attending a  
11 legislative meeting of whatever nature when authorized pursuant to  
12 law, or by the legislative coordinating council, the president of the  
13 senate or the speaker of the house of representatives, and members of  
14 a conference committee attending a meeting of the conference  
15 committee authorized by the president of the senate and the speaker of  
16 the house of representatives during any period of adjournment for  
17 which members are not authorized compensation and allowances  
18 pursuant to K.S.A. 46-137a, and amendments thereto, shall receive  
19 compensation and travel expenses or allowances as provided by  
20 K.S.A. 75-3212, and amendments thereto.  
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
