## 2020 Kansas Statutes

19-502. Condition of bond. The condition of such bond shall be in substance as follows:
"Whereas, the above bounden was elected to the office of county treasurer of
the county of, on theday of; now, therefore, the condition of this
obligation is such, that if the said and his deputy, and all persons employed
in his office, shall faithfully and promptly perform the duties of said office, and if the
said and his deputies shall pay, according to law, all moneys which shall
come to his hands as treasurer, and will render a just and true account thereof
whenever required by said board of commissioners or by any provision of law, and
shall deliver over to his successors in office or to any other person authorized by laws
to receive the same, all moneys, books, papers and other things appertaining thereto
or belonging to his said office, then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to be in
full force and effect."
