## MEMORANDUM

To: House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice From: Office of Revisor of Statutes Date: February 14, 2022 Subject: Bill Brief on HB 2634

HB 2634 requires a waiver of extradition proceedings as a condition of bond.

The bill amends K.S.A. 22-2802, which is the statute about release and the conditions of release prior to trial. The bill adds a new subsection (c) which provides that, in addition to any other conditions of release, the magistrate shall order a person to execute a waiver of extradition (1) stating that the person consents to extradition in Kansas and waives all procedures related to extradition if the person is arrested in another state while on bond, and (2) acknowledging that the person shall not be released prior to trial in any other state pending extradition to Kansas.
