As mandated by Governor Kelly's Executive Order No. 20-53, the Department for Children and Families (DCF) in cooperation with the Kansas State Department of Education (KSDE), is providing you the 2019-20 Foster Care Report Card.

The report card includes 2019-20 school year data elements including:

- A. Graduation rate of students in foster care
- B. Number and percentage of students in foster care who were promoted to the next grade level
- C. State standardized assessment scores for students in foster care, including the number and percentage of students meeting academic standards as determined by the state board of education
- D. Number and percentage of students in foster care enrolled in any preschool-aged at-risk program, Kansas preschool pilot program or early childhood special education program under section 619 of part B of the individuals with disabilities act
- E. Number and percentage of students in foster care who participated in the mental health intervention team pilot program or a similar mental health program
- F. Total number of students in foster care enrolled in a school district or accredited non-public school and disaggregated number and percentage of students in foster care enrolled in school districts and accredited nonpublic schools
- G. De-identified disaggregated race and ethnicity data for each data set required

Please note that KSDE does not have available data related to percentage of students in foster care who were suspended or expelled during the school year. These two data sets were part of the EO.


