Thank you for the opportunity to provide written testimony on HB 2251, the bill which would require relinquishment of firearms pursuant to certain court orders related to domestic violence. As a gun-violence prevention advocate, I urge you to support this bill.
Every month, an average of 53 women in the United States are shot and killed by an intimate partner. Access to a gun makes it five times more likely that a woman will die at the hands of a domestic abuser. When an abuser has been prohibited from possessing firearms, they should not only be prohibited from obtaining new firearms, but also should relinquish guns they may already have. This bill simply helps enforce the current law and closes that dangerous loophole, protecting women and families from armed domestic violence.
