# HOUSE BILL No. 2208

AN ACT concerning the behavioral sciences; relating to the behavioral 1 2 sciences regulatory board; professions regulated thereby; reducing 3 certain licensing requirements; requiring board approval to provide clinical social worker supervision; expanding the board's grounds for 4 5 discipline; expanding temporary permits to practice and imposing 6 requirements for extension thereof; amending K.S.A. 65-5804a, 65-5807a, 65-5808, 65-5809, 65-6309a, 65-6311, 65-6314, 65-6404, 65-7 8 6405a, 65-6408, 65-6610, 65-6612, 65-6615, 74-5316a, 74-5324, 74-9 5363, 74-5367a and 74-5369 and K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 65-6306 and 65-6411 and repealing the existing sections. 10 11 12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

New Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2022, any licensee
 providing postgraduate clinical supervision for any individual working
 toward licensure as a clinical social worker shall be a board-approved
 clinical supervisor.

(b) An application for a board-approved clinical supervisor shall be
made to the board on a form and in the manner prescribed by the board
and shall be accompanied by the fee fixed under K.S.A. 65-5808, and
amendments thereto.

21 (c) Each applicant for board-approved clinical supervisor shall 22 furnish evidence satisfactory to the board that the applicant:

(1) Is currently licensed by the board as a specialist clinical social
 worker and has practiced as a specialist clinical social worker for at least
 two years following licensure;

(2) is not the subject of any disciplinary action of the board that
 would prohibit providing clinical supervision, as determined by the board;
 and

- (3) (A) Has completed the minimum number of semester hours, or
   the academic equivalent, of coursework related to the enhancement of
   supervision skills approved by the board; or
- (B) has completed the minimum number of continuing education
   hours related to the enhancement of supervision skills approved by the
   board.

35 (c) Each board-approved clinical supervisor shall complete, as a part 36 of the continuing education required under K.S.A. 65-6313, and (stricken material in the title)

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amendments thereto, at least three hours of continuing education related to-1 2 the enhancement of supervision skills, including at least one hour related 3 to ethics in supervision.

#### 4 (d) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the social 5 workers licensure act.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 65-5804a is hereby amended to read as follows: 65-6

7 5804a. (a) Applications for licensure as a professional counselor shall be made to the board on a form and in the manner prescribed by the board.

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9 Each application shall be accompanied by the fee fixed under K.S.A. 65-5808, and amendments thereto. 10

(b) Each applicant for licensure as a professional counselor shall 11 furnish evidence satisfactory to the board that the applicant: 12

#### (1) Is at least 21 years of age; 13

(2) has completed 60 graduate semester hours including a graduate 14 degree in counseling or a related field from a college or university 15 approved by the board and that includes 45 graduate semester hours of 16 counseling coursework distributed among each of the following areas: 17

- 18 (A) Counseling theory and practice;
- (B) the helping relationship: 19
- group dynamics, processing and counseling; 20 (C)
- (D) human growth and development; 21
- 22 (E) life-style lifestyle and career development;
- appraisal of individuals; 23 (F)
- (G) social and cultural foundations: 24
- 25 (H) research and evaluation;
- (I) professional orientation; and 26
- 27 (J) supervised practicum and internship;
- 28 (3) has passed an examination required by the board; and

(4) has satisfied the board that the applicant is a person who merits 29 30 the public trust.

(c) (1) Applications for licensure as a clinical professional counselor 31 shall be made to the board on a form and in the manner prescribed by the 32 board. Each applicant shall furnish evidence satisfactory to the board that 33 34 the applicant:

(A) Is licensed by the board as a licensed professional counselor or 35 meets all requirements for licensure as a licensed professional counselor; 36

(B) has completed 15 credit hours, as part of or in addition to the 37 requirements under subsection (b), supporting diagnosis or treatment of 38 mental disorders with use of the American psychiatric association's 39 diagnostic and statistical manual through identifiable study of the 40 following content areas: Psychopathology, diagnostic assessment, 41 interdisciplinary referral and collaboration, treatment approaches and 42 professional ethics; 43

7 (1) Renewal or reinstatement fee for a license as a social work-8 associate shall be not more than \$150.

(3) Application, new license, reinstatement or renewal fee for a license as master social worker shall be not more than \$150.

(4) Application, new license, reinstatement or renewal fee for a
 license in a social work specialty shall be not more than \$150.

(5) Replacement fee for reissuance of a license certificate due to loss
 or name change shall be not more than \$20.

17 (6) Replacement fee for reissuance of a wallet card shall be not more 18 than \$5.

(7) Temporary license fee for a baccalaureate social worker, master social worker or a social work specialty shall be not more than \$50.

21 (8) Application fee for approval as board-approved continuing 22 education sponsors shall be as follows:

23 (A) Initial application fee for one year provisionally approved
 24 providers shall be not more than \$125;

(B) three-year renewal fees for approved providers shall be not more than \$350; and

27 (C) application fees for single program providers shall be not more
 28 than \$50 for each separately offered continuing education activity for

29 which prior approval is sought.

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30 (9) Application fee for approval as a board-approved clinical
 31 supervisor shall be not more than \$50.

## (b) Fees paid to the board are not refundable.

Sec. 10. K.S.A. 65-6404 is hereby amended to read as follows: 65-6404. (a) An applicant for licensure as a marriage and family therapist
shall furnish evidence that the applicant *has*:

36 (1) Has Attained the age of 21 years of age;

37 (2) (A) has-completed a master's or doctoral degree from a marriage

39 approved by the board;-or (B) has completed a master's or doctoral degree
