Subject: Bill Brief on HB 2473

HB 2473 removes the requirement that all district court judges in Douglas county serve on the board of trustees of the law library.

The bill amends K.S.A. 20-3127. Current law in that section allows the board of trustees of a law library in Johnson or Sedgwick counties to be made up to two district court judges and three members of the county's bar association but requires the board of trustees of a law library in any other county to be make up of all the district court judges in that county and no fewer than two attorneys in the county. This bill would apply the provisions that currently apply to Johnson and Sedgwick counties to Douglas county.
