Subject: House Bill No. 2070

Summary

As background, K.S.A. 16a-2-403 generally prohibits a seller in any transaction from imposing a surcharge on a card holder who elects to use a credit or debit card in lieu of payment by cash, check or similar means. Pursuant to the statue – a surcharge is any additional amount imposed at the time of the sales transaction by the seller that increases the charge to the buyer for the privilege of using a credit or debit card.

Under the bill, K.S.A. 75-30,100 provides exceptions from the prohibition against imposing the surcharge in K.S.A. 16a-2-403. The bill would expand the exception to include non-for-profit private postsecondary educational institutions and educational institutions otherwise exempt from the Kansas private and out-of-state postsecondary educational institution act thereby allowing such institutions the ability to impose the surcharge when payment is made with a credit or debit card.
