We want to thank Chairman Proehl and the Committee members for allowing the League of Kansas Municipalities to provide neutral testimony on HB 2014.

HB 2014 allows for military surplus vehicles, other than fully tracked vehicles, to be registered and driven on Kansas roads.

The League is neutral as to whether, in general, military surplus vehicles should be allowed on Kansas roads. We appreciate the work done on this bill since it was first introduced in the previous session. As now drafted, military surplus vehicles will comply with size and weight limits mandated by the Uniform Act Regulating Traffic. These changes answer the safety concerns that the League had with the previous version and we thank Representative Williams for introducing a bill this year that reflects those changes.
