HB 2628 expands the definition of reckless driving to include anyone who operates a vehicle at 100 mph or more. K.S.A. 8-1566 provides the current definition of reckless driving as any person who drives any vehicle in willful or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property. The operation of a vehicle at 100 mph or more will be added to that definition. Penalties and fines provided in K.S.A 8-1566 for reckless driving will remain unchanged.
