Subject: Bill Brief – SB 446

SB 446 designates bridges on United States highway 166 and K-66 highway each as the Veterans Memorial Bridge.

Section 1 provides the Bridge No. 0011-B0109 located on U.S. 166 in Cherokee County and Bridge No. 0011-B0072 and Bridge No. 0011-B0005 both located on K-66 highway in Cherokee County are all designated as the Veterans Memorial Bridge.

Signs designating each of these bridges as Veterans Memorial Bridge will not be placed until the requirements of K.S.A. 68-10,114 are met. K.S.A. 68-10,114 provides that the secretary of transportation should not place any signs designating memorial highways until receiving sufficient funds from gifts and donations to cover the costs of those signs. Additionally, the secretary must receive an additional 50% of the initial cost to pay for future maintenance or replacement costs for the signs.
