Subject: SB 391 – Requiring the number of years in office be provided by an

incumbent candidate's name on the ballot.

Senate Bill No. 391 (SB 391) would require the Secretary of State to develop a ballot system to include the number of years of service in office on the ballot for an incumbent candidate running for reelection. The number of years of service would be provided next to the candidate's name on the ballot.

If enacted, SB 391 would become effective on July 1, 2022.
