Subject: House Bill No. 2167

## **Summary**

House Bill No. 2167 permits concrete mixer trucks to display a license plate on the front of the vehicle and requires dump trucks to display license plates on the front of the vehicle.

<u>Section 1</u> – Subsection (b)(4) provides that the license plate issued for a concrete mixer truck may be attached to either the front or the rear of the vehicle. Subsection (b)(5) requires a dump truck with a gross weight of 26,000 pounds or more to attach a license plate to the front of the vehicle.

Subsection (e) requires a law enforcement officer to issue a warning citation to anyone violating subsection (b)(5) relating to dump truck license plates. The warning citation is only required through January 1, 2022.
