Subject: House Bill No. 2476

Summary

House Bill No. 2476 provides for two new distinctive license plates – the Silver Star Medal and Bronze Star Medal distinctive license plates. Each plate would only be available to those individuals who were awarded the Silver Star Medal and the Bronze Star Medal by the United States Government, respectively. The plate would not be transferable to any other person.

The plates would be exempt from the requirements set forth in K.S.A. 8-1,141 that includes the initial plate commitment and payment of development costs.

The surviving spouse, or other family member, if there is no surviving spouse shall be entitled to possession of such plate in the event of the death of the person issued the plate. The plate would be precluded from being displayed on any vehicle.
