

I am writing in support of SB 353. About 3 years ago I moved back to my parent's farmhouse, it is located about a mile to mile and a half northeast as the crow flies from the Irish Creek Project. The house sets low in what I would call a small north and south valley, and depending on the direction, and the m.p.h. of the wind I can hear the turbine noise periodically. It is not all the time, I mostly notice it more later in the day and evening, but that is when I'm outside. The noise is real, that is why I am in favor of setbacks for at least one mile from homes. The Irish Creek project has so many homes and families living less than a mile from turbines. I have seen the flickering within that distance and if you can hear the noise from my distance I know how loud it is for those closer. In the future, the State of Kansas has to put out restrictions and protect our residents living in these areas.
