KANSAS PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP ACT

The 2021 Legislature enacted House Bill 2064 creating the new scholarship and designating the Kansas Board of Regents (Board) as the administrator of the new program. The Kansas Promise Scholarship Act (Promise Scholarship) provides scholarships for students to attend an eligible postsecondary institution for two-year associate degree programs, career and technical education certificates, or stand-alone programs otherwise identified by the Board, with an expectation that the student obtain a credential in one of those areas and upon completion reside and work in Kansas for two years.

PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM

The purpose of the grant program is to offer Kansans the opportunity to earn a credential in high demand fields, including information technology and security, mental and physical healthcare, advanced manufacturing and building trades, and early childhood education and development and to provide Kansas industries with the employees they need in these fields.

INSTITUTIONS

Institutions of higher education eligible to participate in the Promise Scholarship program are designated in the legislation to include the public community and technical colleges, Washburn Institute of Technology, and any independent, not-for-profit accredited postsecondary institution that offers a program eligible under the Act.

The participating institutions include:

Institutions were charged with making individual awards to eligible students (including verification of students' eligibility), entering into a Promise Scholarship service agreement with each student awarded a scholarship, and creating and maintaining student-level records as required by the Board of Regents to document satisfaction of the bill's requirements. Institutions were instructed to credit their Promise Scholarship funds to the recipients' accounts to pay the appropriate amount of tuition, required fees, books, and required materials for the eligible program in which the student enrolls.

Each institution signed an agreement with the Board of Regents to formalize, for the first year of the program, when disbursement of state funds from the Board to the institution occurs, to identify the allowed and prohibited expenditures of the state funds, to identify the institution's responsibilities with regard to administering, publicizing, and reporting on the state funds.

STUDENTS

The requirements for students to qualify for the Kansas Promise Scholarship are as follows:

To be eligible for a Kansas Promise Scholarship award, a student must:

- Be a Kansas resident; AND
- Meet one of the following criteria:
 - Have graduated from a Kansas secondary school within the preceding 12 months; or
 - Have attended a Kansas secondary school and, within the preceding 12 months obtained a high school equivalency credential; or
 - Be 21 years of age or older and a Kansas resident for the preceding three consecutive years; or
 - Be a dependent child of a military servicemember permanently stationed in another state; for dependent children of military servicemembers stationed in another state, the applicant must have, within the preceding 12 months, graduated from any out-of-state secondary school or obtained a high school equivalency.

To receive a Kansas Promise Scholarship award (initial or renewal), the student must also:

- Complete the required Kansas Promise Scholarship application; and
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA); and
- Enter into a Kansas Promise Scholarship Agreement (only at initial application); and
- Enroll in an eligible program at an eligible institution (may be part-time or full-time but enrolled in at least six hours per semester).

To be eligible to renew a Kansas Promise Scholarship and avoid repayment of the award, the student must also maintain satisfactory academic progress toward completion of their Promise Scholarship eligible program and complete their Promise Scholarship eligible program for which the scholarship was awarded within 30 months of the date that the scholarship was first awarded.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Within certain income guidelines, students may receive a scholarship in the amount of:

- Aggregate amount of tuition, required fees, books, and required materials
- Less all other aid, grants, scholarships, or financial assistance awards that do not require repayment.

For eligible students attending a four-year eligible postsecondary institution, the scholarship award is limited to the average cost of what is charged by a two-year eligible public institution offering the same program.

Scholarships are to be prioritized according to applicants' annual household income:

- \$100,000 or less for a family of two;
- \$150,000 or less for a family of three; and
- \$150,000 + \$4,800 per additional family member beyond three.

If funds remain after awarding eligible applicants, other students with greater household income may become eligible.

KANSAS BOARD OF REGENTS DUTIES

The Act requires the Board to adopt rules and regulations on or before March 1, 2022, pertaining to:

- Application deadlines for the scholarship;
- The appeals process for denial or revocation of a scholarship;
- Transferability of a graduated student's credits from an institution to a state educational institution or a municipal university;
- The terms, conditions, and requirements of the scholarship agreement to be entered by each student who receives a scholarship;
- Procedures for requesting and approving certain absences from an institution (to stop the 30-month program completion clock);
- Criteria for determining whether a student has fulfilled the employment and repayment requirements specified in the bill and the scholarship agreement; and
- Criteria for determining whether special circumstances or good cause are present that prevent a student from completing the scholarship requirements.

The Kansas Board of Regents has initiated the process of drafting rules and regulations. As of the date this report was submitted, the Board has solicited feedback from stakeholders and submitted the regulations to the Director of the Budget and the Department of Administration for review. Until such time as regulations could be finally adopted, agreements with each participating eligible institution were drafted, negotiated with all parties, and signed.

The Kansas Promise Scholarship Act also requires the Board to identify the eligible programs that are in the following fields of study:

- Information technology and security;
- Physical and mental health care;
- Early childhood education and development;
- Advanced manufacturing and building trades; and
- A program designated by the institution according to Section 3 of the bill.

The Postsecondary Technical Education Authority assisted the Board of Regents in the process of identifying programs submitted by the eligible institutions. As of the date this report was submitted, 676 programs have been identified by the Board as eligible for a Promise Scholarship.

The Act also requires the Board to:

- Work with community partners to publicize the Promise Scholarship program;
- Disburse funds to each institution;
- Request information from each institution;
- Ensure students fulfill the scholarship agreement; and
- Starting in January 2022, annually evaluate the Promise Scholarship program and report to the standing education committees of the House of Representatives and the Senate.

The Governor signed the Act into law on April 23, 2021. Immediately after, the Board of Regents began the process of administering the new program, which took effect on July 1, 2021.

- A standard application and scholarship agreement were created and distributed to all eligible institutions;
- An agreement establishing the terms under which the State funds were being distributed to each institution in the first year of the program was drafted, negotiated, and executed with each eligible institution;
- FAQs were developed to assist institutions with implementation;
- Webinars were conducted to assist institutions with implementation; and
- The Board's Director of Financial Aid worked one-on-one with institutions' financial aid offices as needed.

With all of this in place, the Board was able to begin distributing funds to each institution as it entered its agreement, beginning the week of July 1, 2021.

STATE APPROPRIATION

The Kansas Board of Regents received a \$10 million appropriation for FY 2022 and FY 2023 (Sections 48(a) and 49(a) of 2021 Senate Bill 159). Beginning in FY 2024, subsequent appropriations are not to exceed 150% of the preceding year's expenditures.

For purposes of planning for administration of this program, it has been assumed that the entire appropriation is to be used for student awards and cannot be used for administration of the program.

To determine how much of the appropriation to make available to the participating eligible institutions for scholarship awards, student enrollment data of Kansas resident students in the Promise Act eligible programs was reviewed for the three prior years. The \$10.0 million was then apportioned across the institutions according to the size of the three-year average enrollment in those programs but placing a floor of \$100,000 to five institutions with smaller enrollments (Independence Community College, Salina Area Technical College, Hesston College, Cleveland University-KC, and Donnelly College).

Once an institution executed its agreement with the Board of Regents, a disbursement representing one-third of their annual share was made to the institution, most of which was sent in mid-July but continued through mid-August as executed agreements were received by the Board of Regents. Additional distributions were made in September to cover the greater demand at some institutions in Fall semester. Second distributions were made in early January to meet projected enrollments for the balance of the year. If there is greater demand than the current funding received, an additional disbursement will be made to institutions during the Spring semester.

DATA COLLECTIONS

In the Summer of 2021, the Board of Regents began the process of determining the data fields necessary to be gathered from the participating institutions in order to fulfill the Board's obligation to report to the Legislature in January 2022. A webinar was held by Board of Regents for the employees at the public colleges responsible for submitting the Promise Act data in late August, and for the private independent institutions in October. Using the Board's secure data submission system, the data collection was established and opened to institutions on November 1 and closed on November 30, 2021.

For the public institutions, the information necessary for providing future Promise Scholarship reports will be requested within the annual KHEDS data collection. A webinar to review the KHEDS updates for the Promise Act will be held for field staff in February.

For the private institutions participating, there will remain an annual, separate data collection.

The information submitted in November 2021 was reviewed and validated, with the results of that collection attached to this report. In total, there were 663 Promise Act recipients in Fall 2021, enrolled in the following program types:
