
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2544 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2544 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2544 would add persons credentialed in the field of nutrition, who are not dietitians or licensed dietitians or use the titles in combination with other titles or use the abbreviation L.D. to the list of those that insurers would not be required to provide health insurance coverage for the services provided. The bill would also require credentialed persons to provide specific information to the credentialing body before the person performs services related to nutrition.

The Kansas Insurance Department indicates that HB 2544 would have no fiscal effect on the Department.
