
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2681 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2681 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2681 would require certain seized and forfeited firearms or ammunition in the possession of a law enforcement agency to be disposed of in accordance with KSA 22-2512. The bill would also remove provisions requiring law enforcement agencies to submit annual forfeiture fund reports to the Legislature.

The Office of Judicial Administration, Kansas Bureau of Investigation, and Highway Patrol indicate enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect.
