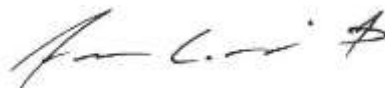
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 550 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 550 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 550 would allow certain individuals with revoked drivers' licenses to be eligible for restricted driving privileges upon submitting a written request to the Division of Vehicles. A person would not qualify for restricted driving privileges under these provisions if the person has been convicted for driving with a canceled, suspended, or revoked license more than three times or if, at the time of application, is suspended for any other reason. The bill would require the Division to cancel restricted driving privileges for any person authorized to have restricted driving privileges under these provisions if the person is found guilty of a violation resulting in a license suspension, revocation, or cancellation for reasons other than failure to comply with a traffic citation.

The Kansas Department of Revenue indicates the enactment of SB 550 may increase costs for staff training and form and application updates, but those costs could be absorbed within existing resources. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 550 is not reflected in *The FY 2023 Governor's Budget Report*.
