Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 32-1129 is hereby amended to read as follows: 32-1129. (a) The operator of every vessel shall require every (1) No operator of any vessel may operate such vessel while any person 12 years of age or under-to-wear is aboard or being towed by such vessel unless such person is either:

- (A) Wearing a United States coast-Guard approved type I, type II or type III guard-approved personal flotation device as prescribed in rules and regulations of the secretary of wildlife, parks and tourism—while aboard or being towed by such vessel; or
 - (B) is below decks or in an enclosed cabin.
- 17 (2) A life belt or ring shall not satisfy the requirement of this section.
 - (b) Violation of subsection (a) shall constitute a class C misdemeanor.
- 19 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 32-1129 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book **Kansas register**.
