Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 25-2306 is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-2306. The application for registration shall include a statement by the applicant that he will have reached the age of eighteen (18) years before the next statewide general election (a) Any person 16 years of age or older may apply to register to vote. If the applicant is under 18 years of age, the secretary of state shall suspend such applicant's registration until such time as the person reaches 18 years of age.

- (b) No person may vote at any election until-he such person has 14 reached the age of eighteen (18) 18 years of age.
- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 25-2306 is hereby repealed. 15
