1 AN ACT concerning property taxation; relating to valuation of certain 2 mobile homes and manufactured homes; requiring use of the same 3 valuation methodology therefor; amending K.S.A. 79-340 and 4 repealing the existing section.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 79-340 is hereby amended to read as follows: 79-8 340. Except as otherwise provided in this section, a mobile home or 9 manufactured home, for purposes of taxation, shall be considered to be 10 personal property, unless title to the mobile home or manufactured home is 11 vested in the same person or the spouse of such person who holds title to 12 the real property upon which such mobile home or manufactured home is 13 located and such mobile home or manufactured home has a permanent 14 foundation, such foundation being of a type not removable intact from 15 such real property. Any mobile home or manufactured home used as a 16 dwelling or residence shall be appraised for ad valorem tax purposes in the same manner as real property. A mobile home or manufactured home used 17 as a dwelling or residence considered to be real property pursuant to this 18 19 section shall be appraised using the same valuation methodology as used 20 for a mobile home or manufactured home used as a dwelling or residence 21 considered to be personal property. Such valuation methodology shall 22 consider the replacement cost new less depreciation, including physical 23 deterioration or functional, economic or social obsolescence, of the 24 mobile home or manufactured home. For the purposes of this section and K.S.A. 79-335, 79-336 and 79-337, and amendments thereto, the terms 25 26 "mobile home" and "manufactured home" shall have the meanings 27 respectively ascribed to such terms by K.S.A. 58-4202, and amendments 28 thereto.
