AN ACT concerning government contracts; enacting the firearm industry 1 nondiscrimination act: prohibiting certain contracts with entities that 2 3 discriminate against firearm or ammunition industries. 4 5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:* 6 Section 1. The provisions of sections 1 through 3, and amendments 7 thereto, shall be known and may be cited as the firearm industry 8 nondiscrimination act. 9 Sec. 2. As used in this section and section 3, and amendments thereto: 10 (a) "Ammunition" means a loaded cartridge case, primer bullet or 11 propellant powder with or without a projectile. 12 (b) (1) "Company" means an organization, association, corporation, 13 partnership, venture or other entity, its subsidiary or affiliate that: (A) Exists to make a profit or to otherwise secure economic 14 15 advantage; and (B) has no fewer than 10 full-time employees. 16 The term "company" does not include a sole proprietorship. 17 (2)"Contract" means a written agreement between a governmental 18 (c)19 entity and a company that has a purchase price of not less than \$100,000 20 that is paid, in whole or in part, from moneys held by or appropriated for 21 such governmental entity that are public funds. 22 (d) (1) "Discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade 23 association" means, with respect to such entity or association, to do any of 24 the following based solely on such entity's or association's status as a 25 firearm entity or firearm trade association: 26 (A) Refuse to engage in the trade of any goods or services with such 27 entity or association; 28 (B) refrain from continuing an existing business relationship with 29 such entity or association; or 30 (C) terminate an existing business relationship with such entity or 31 association. 32 (2) The term "discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade 33 association" does not include: 34 (A) The established policies of a merchant, retailer or platform that 35 restrict or prohibit the listing or selling of ammunition, firearms or firearm 36 accessories; or

1 (B) a company's refusal to engage in the trade of any goods or 2 services, decision to refrain from continuing an existing business relationship or decision to terminate an existing business relationship: 3

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(i) To comply with federal, state or local law, policy or rules and regulations or a directive by a regulatory agency; or

(ii) for any traditional business reason that is specific to the customer 6 7 or potential customer and not based solely on an entity's or association's 8 status as a firearm entity or firearm trade association.

9 (e) "Firearm" has the same meaning as defined in K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 10 21-5111, and amendments thereto.

(f) "Firearm accessory" means a device specifically designed or 11 adapted to enable an individual to wear, carry, store or mount a firearm on 12 the individual or on a conveyance and an item used in conjunction with or 13 14 mounted on a firearm that is not essential to the basic function of the firearm. The term "firearm accessory" includes a detachable firearm 15 16 magazine.

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(g) "Firearm entity" means:

18 (1) A manufacturer, distributor, wholesaler, supplier or retailer of 19 firearms, firearms accessories or ammunition; or

20 (2) a sport shooting range.

21 (h) "Firearm trade association" means any person, corporation, 22 association, federation, business league or other organization that:

23 (1) Is not organized or operated for profit and for which none of its 24 net earnings inures to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual; 25

(2) has two or more firearm entities as members; and

(3) is exempt from federal income taxation under section 501(a) of 26 27 the federal internal revenue code of 1986 as an organization described in 28 section 501(c) of the federal internal revenue code of 1986.

(i) "Governmental entity" means any office or officer, department, 29 board, commission, institution or bureau of this state or any agency, 30 31 division or unit within any office, department, board, commission or other 32 state authority and any political subdivision of this state.

"Sport shooting range" means an organization, association, 33 (i) 34 corporation, partnership, venture or other entity that operates an area for 35 the discharge or other use of firearms for silhouette, skeet, trap, black 36 powder, target, self-defense or similar recreational shooting.

37 Sec. 3. (a) Except as otherwise provide, on and after July 1, 2022, a 38 governmental entity shall not enter into any contract with a company for 39 the purchase of goods or services unless such contract includes a written 40 certification by such company that such company:

41 (1) Does not have a practice, policy, guidance or directive that 42 discriminates against a firearm entity or firearm trade association; and

43 (2) will not discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade

- association during the term of such contract.
- (b) This section shall not apply to a governmental entity that contracts with a sole-source provider or does not receive any bids from a company that is able to provide the written certification required by subsection (a). Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
- publication in the statute book.
