## 2021 Kansas Statutes

- 44-1607. Patrons of amusement rides, acceptance of risk, duties. (a) Each patron of an amusement ride, antique amusement ride, limited-use amusement ride or registered agritourism activity, by participation, accepts the risks inherent in such participation of which an ordinary prudent person is or should be aware.
- (b) Each patron of a ride has a duty to:
- (1) Exercise the judgment and act in the manner of an ordinary prudent person while participating in a ride;
- (2) obey all instructions and warnings, written or oral, prior to and during participation in a ride;
- (3) refrain from participation in a ride while under the influence of alcohol or drugs;
- (4) engage all safety devices that are provided;
- (5) refrain from disconnecting or disabling any safety device except at the express direction of the owner's agent or employee; and
- (6) refrain from extending arms and legs beyond the carrier or seating area except at the express direction of the owner's agent or employee.
- (c) Any parent or guardian of a patron shall have a duty to reasonably ensure that the patron complies with all provisions of this act.
