50-679. Same; **cause of action**; **priority over enhanced civil penalty**. A protected consumer who suffers damage or injury as a result of a violation of the Kansas consumer protection act has a cause of action to recover actual damages, punitive damages, if appropriate, and reasonable attorney fees.
