

2021 Kansas Statutes

53-5a08. Authority to refuse to perform notarial act. (a) A notarial officer may refuse to perform a notarial act if the officer is not satisfied that the:

- (1) Individual executing the record is competent or has the capacity to execute the record;
or
 - (2) individual's signature is knowingly and voluntarily made.
- (b) A notarial officer may refuse to perform a notarial act unless refusal is prohibited by the law of this state or by federal law.
- (c) This section shall take effect on and after January 1, 2022.
