

2021 Kansas Statutes

72-6315. Collection of biometric data prohibited. No school district shall collect biometric data from a student, or use any device or mechanism to assess a student's physiological or emotional state, unless the student, if an adult, or the parent or legal guardian of the student, if a minor, consents in writing.
