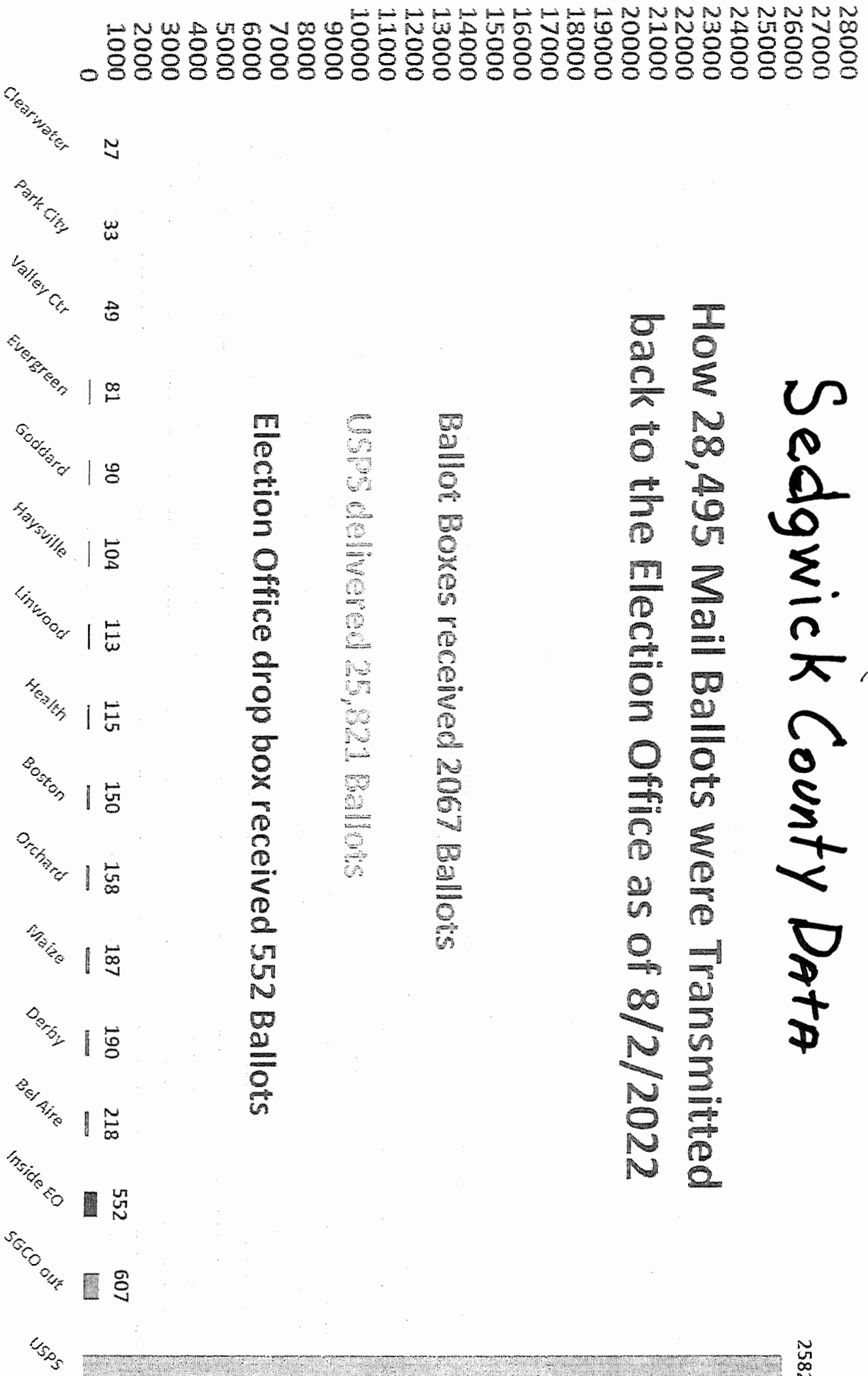

<b>USPS MAILBOXES</b>	<b>REMOTE BALLOT BOXES</b>
Secured and locked	Secured and locked
Wide slot to accept a lot of mail at one time	Super skinny slot to only accept one or two ballots at one time
A motivated thief could fish out some Mail	It's impossible to fish out ballots
Mailboxes sometimes located on private property in dark areas	Ballot boxes are located on government property in well lit area
No dedicated camera recordings of activities	Dedicated cameras capture activities at ballot boxes
Mail picked up by a single postal worker	Ballots are picked up by bipartisan election worker teams
Ballots are mingled with other mail and not logged	Ballots are counted, logged, and placed in secure transport packaging
Ballots may leave the state of Kansas before delivery	Ballots are directly delivered to election office
Many days before delivery	Delivery to the election office is immediate
No one knows who handled the ballots	Names of bi partisan election workers that pickup is logged
Does not require a stamp to be delivered K.S.A.25-433(b)	Does not require a stamp to be delivered
Harvesters could drop as many ballots as they wish undetected	Harvesters could drop 11 or more but at least there's video
Felony crime to use mail to mail fake ballots	Imitation of disinterested voters or a dead voter is a crime in ballot boxes
