NEUTRAL POSITION ON HB 2264

WE ABSOLUTELY SUPPORT A PATIENT'S RIGHT TO VISITATION. The impacts of the pandemic and the rules and regulations related to it were very traumatic. We all did our best to ensure that no person passed alone in our care facilities.

Many adult care homes are regulated by the federal government through the rules of participation from the Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services. This means that if <u>HB 2264 is passed into law our adult care homes will be faced with fines, penalties, loss of federal funding or loss of licensure to provide care if those adult care homes break federal requirements to follow state law, and that puts our adult care homes in an untenable situation.</u>

KACE would support HB 2264 if a provision is added that will allow federally licensed adult care homes to follow federal requirements, regulation, or statute, if those requirements, regulation, or statute conflict with the provisions set forth in HB 2264. Adult care home professionals always act to provide compassion and humanity to all Kansans living in our communities, and we hope our testimony conveys the struggle adult care homes face between moral integrity and the federal regulatory compliance that has the authority to close our homes.
