I am writing to voice my opposition to bill SB128.

I oppose bill SB83 and voucher programs in general.

- Public tax dollars should remain with our public schools that accept and educate all children.
- Instead of funding private schools, the legislature should focus on fully funding special education, which currently has a shortfall of \$160 million.
- Private schools that can pick and choose which children they want to serve should NOT receive our public dollars.
- Rural students (and communities) are harmed as public-school resources are drained and students lack little to no private options. Rural communities will end up subsidizing private school tuition for families in metro areas.

My husband and I decided to move from MO to KS specifically for the amazing public education systemarguably one of the best in the country. I was born and raised in Johnson County and wanted our children to experience the same wonderful educational experience I did. We should be proud of that and continue to enhance it by FULLY FUNDING SPECIAL EDUCATION, not diverting money to private schools that would never accept one of my children.

As a parent of a child with an IEP and in the SPED program at SMSD, I am appalled that this bill being put forth exists. The SPED program is crucial to children like my son. He receives services (OT/Speech) within SMSD that he would never receive at a private school. We need to uplift, respect, and educate ALL children regardless of ability.

This is not a "school choice" bill. This is a "shift the cost of someone's choice to send their kids to private schools onto everyone else" bill. We all pay for public schools- people without kids and people with kids that aren't school age- because they keep our neighborhoods strong, and they bolster our property values.

Do the right thing and vote NO on bill SB128!
