
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 387 by Senate Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 387 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 387 would clarify current law regarding K-12 student enrollment. The bill would provide for the continued enrollment for students who attend a school district of non-residence according to the school district open enrollment law, which began in school year 2024-2025. This provision would end when the student graduates from high school or if the student would be deemed “no longer in good standing.”

According to the Department of Education, the enactment of SB 387 would not affect state aid to school districts and would have no fiscal effect for the agency.
