Subject: Senate Bill No. 142

Summary

Senate Bill No. 142 requires that in the event that a motor vehicle is stopped with hazard warning lights, road flares or caution signals, the driver of an approaching motor vehicle shall either: (1) change lanes if possible; or (2) proceed in the same lane with due caution and reduced speed to maintain a safe speed. Violations would result in a fine of \$75.
