

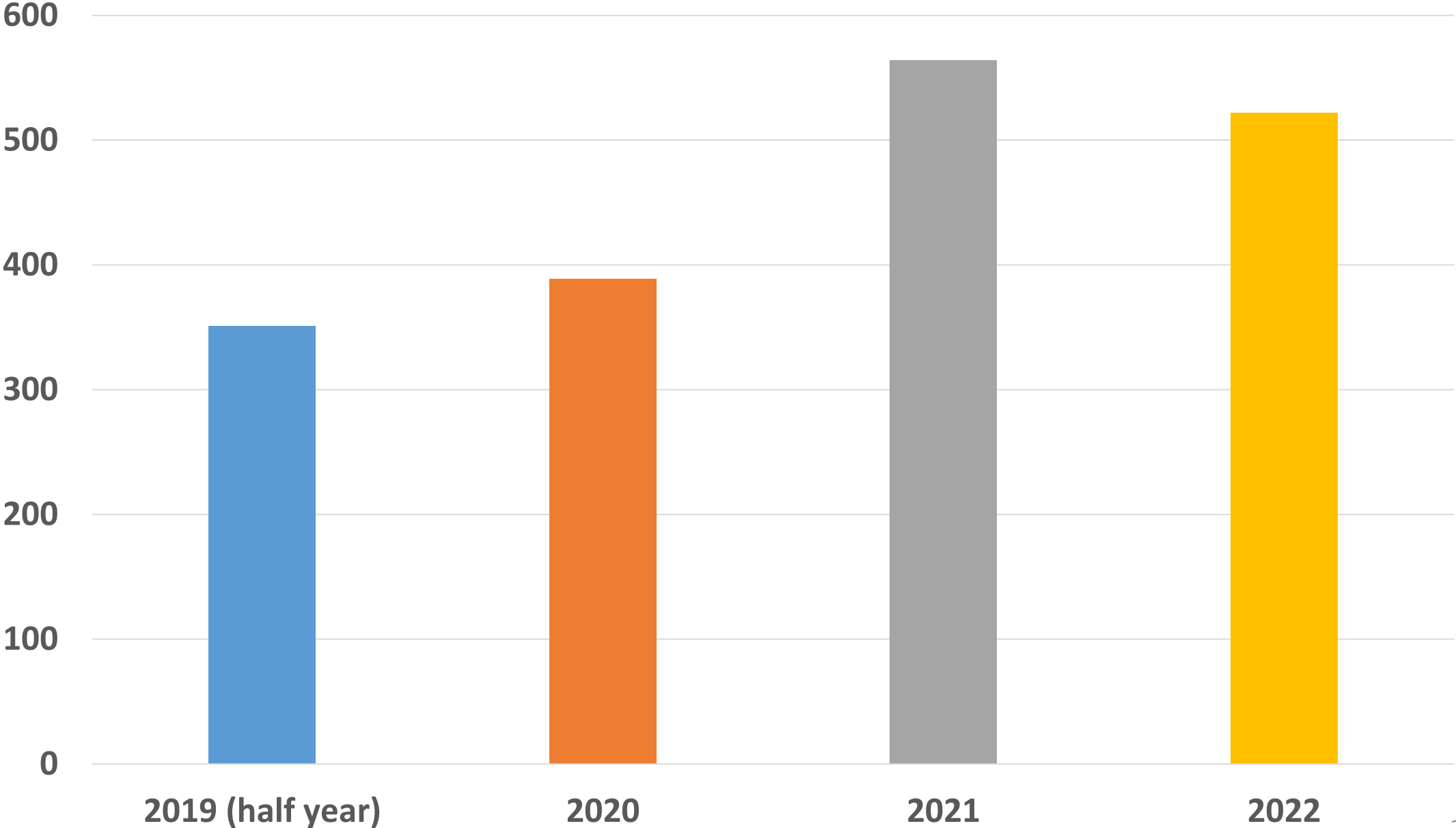

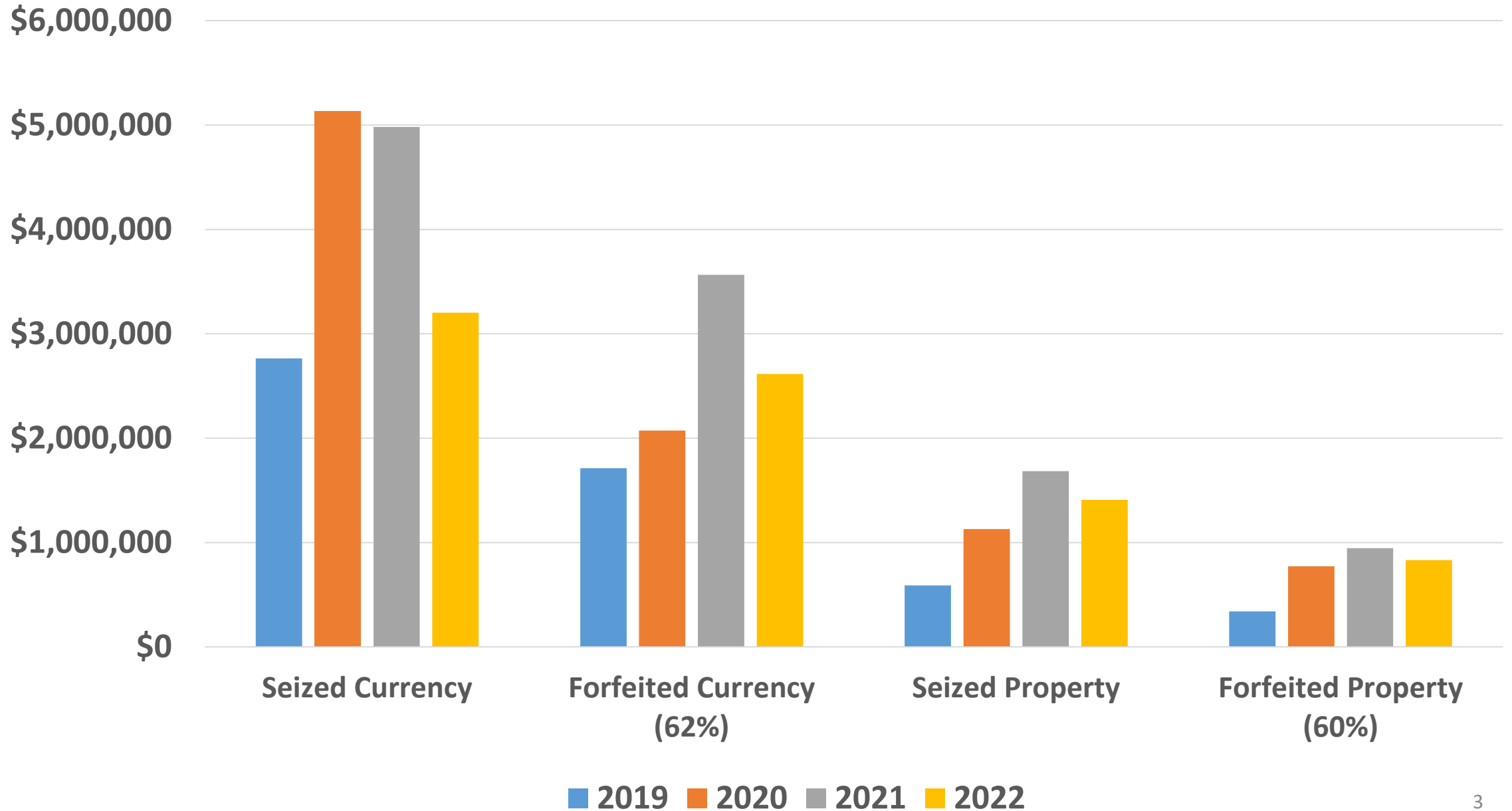

Return to Owner and Federal Forfeitures

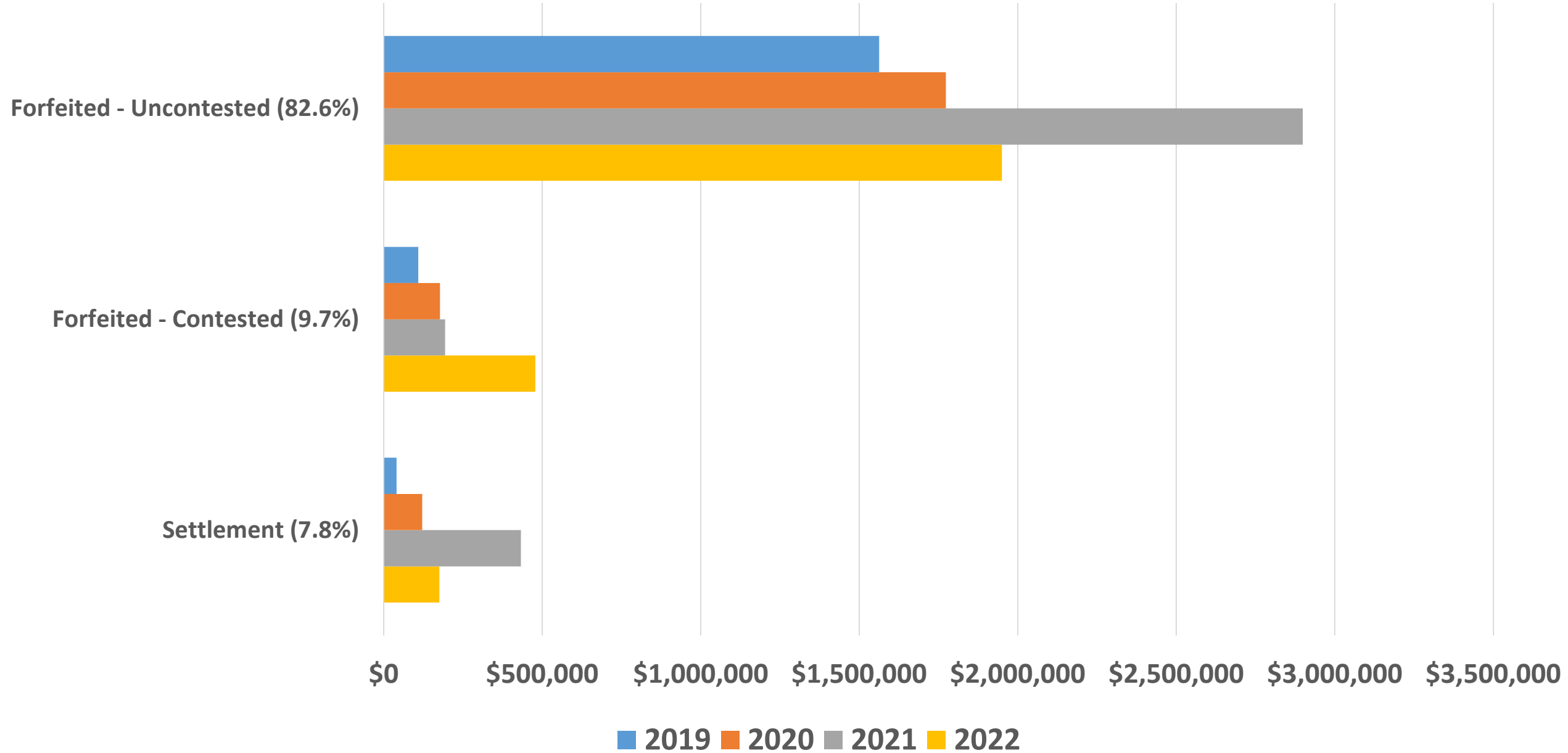
(7/1/2019-11/8/2023)

- Recovery Rate (Incidents) – 499 out of 2000 (25%)
- Recovery Rate (Value) - \$4,141,591.93 out of \$5,151,463.33 (80%)

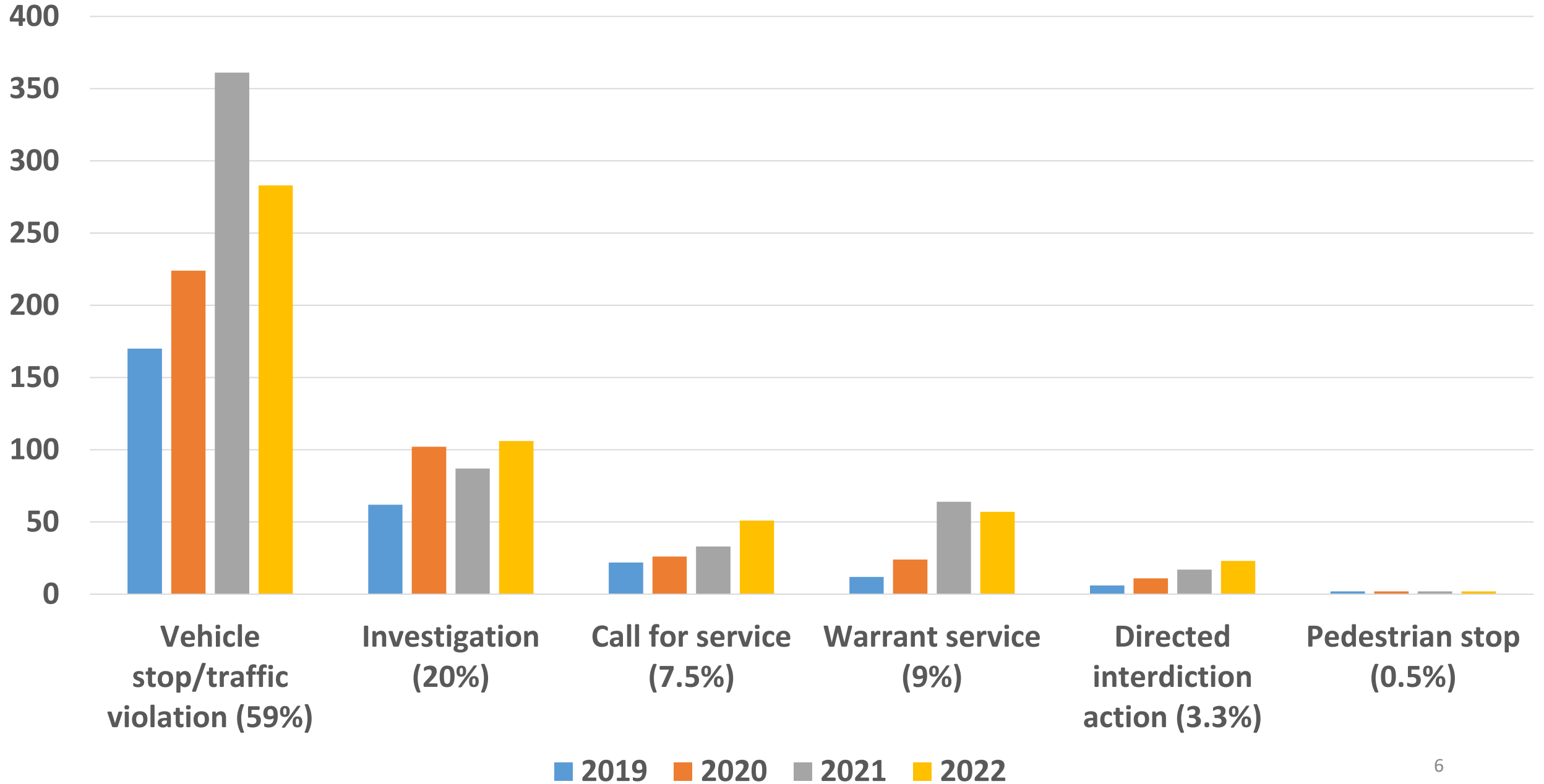
*Note, this percentage is based on the values reported in the 499 incident reports that included any returned property.

- Average Days to Recovery – 249 days
- Transfer for Federal Forfeiture
 - Incidents – 116 out of 2000 (5.8%)
 - Value
 - Currency - \$5,621,720.84
 - Property - \$89,184.00

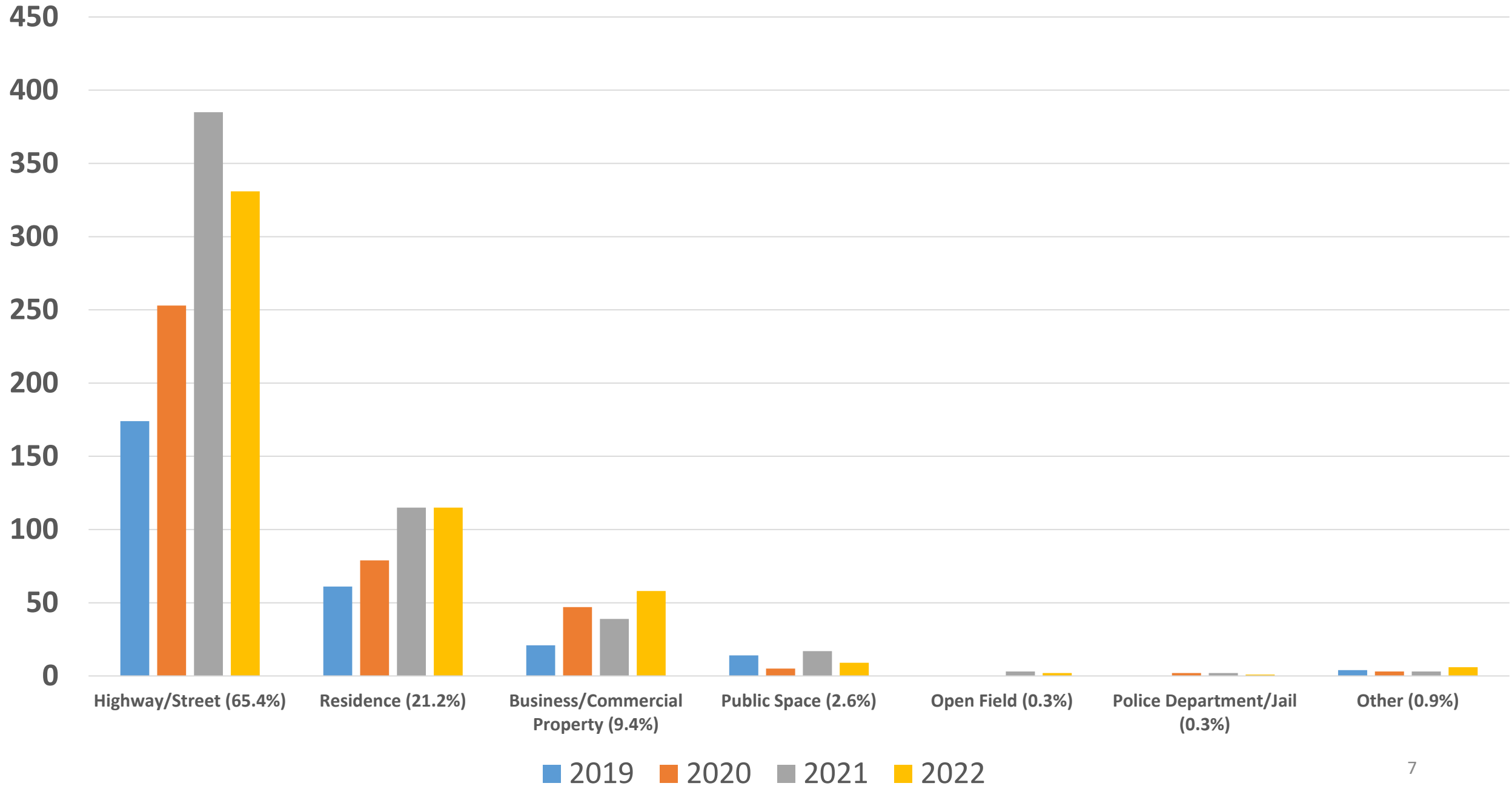
Forfeited Currency - State Forfeiture Case Disposition



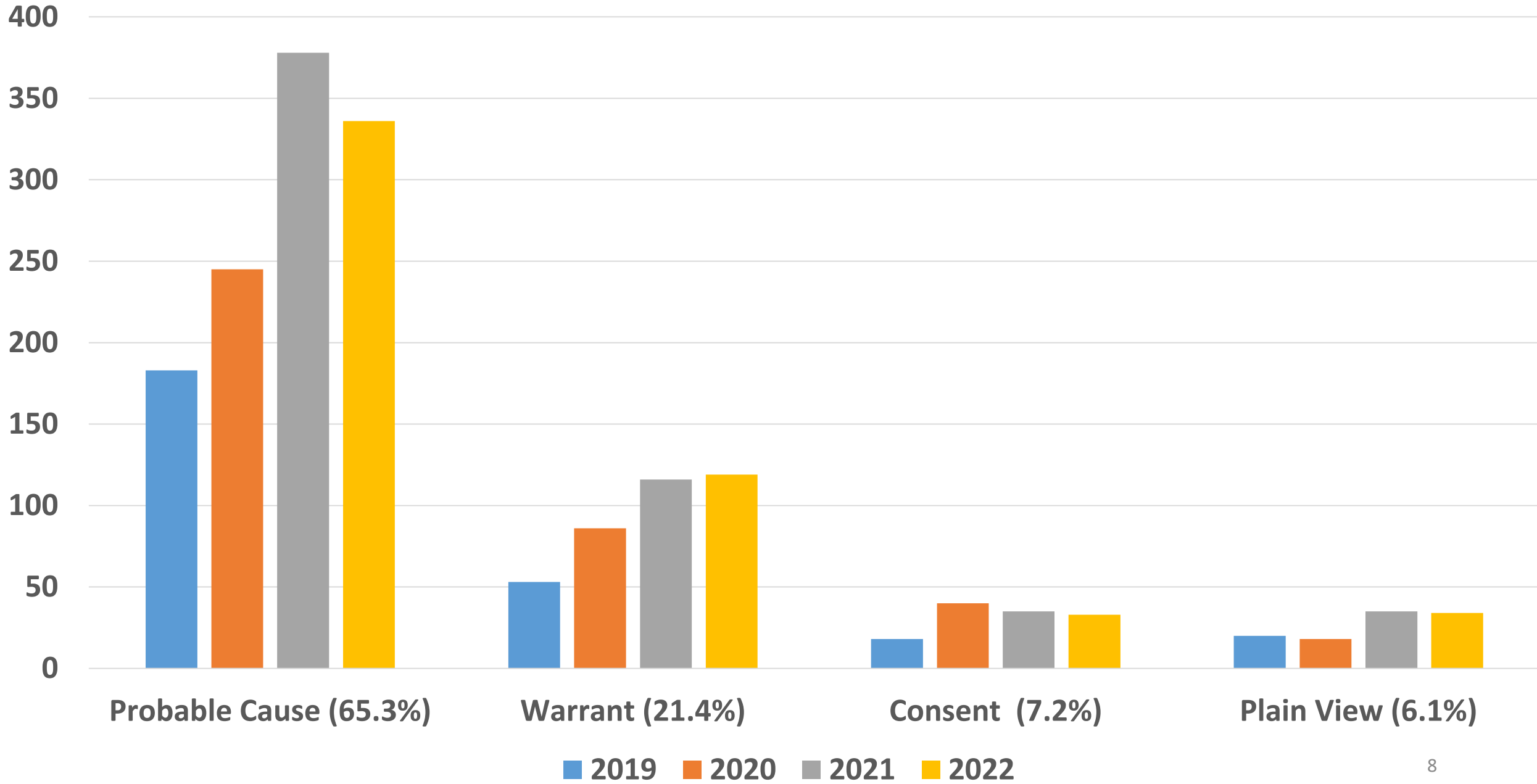
Initiating Law Enforcement Activity



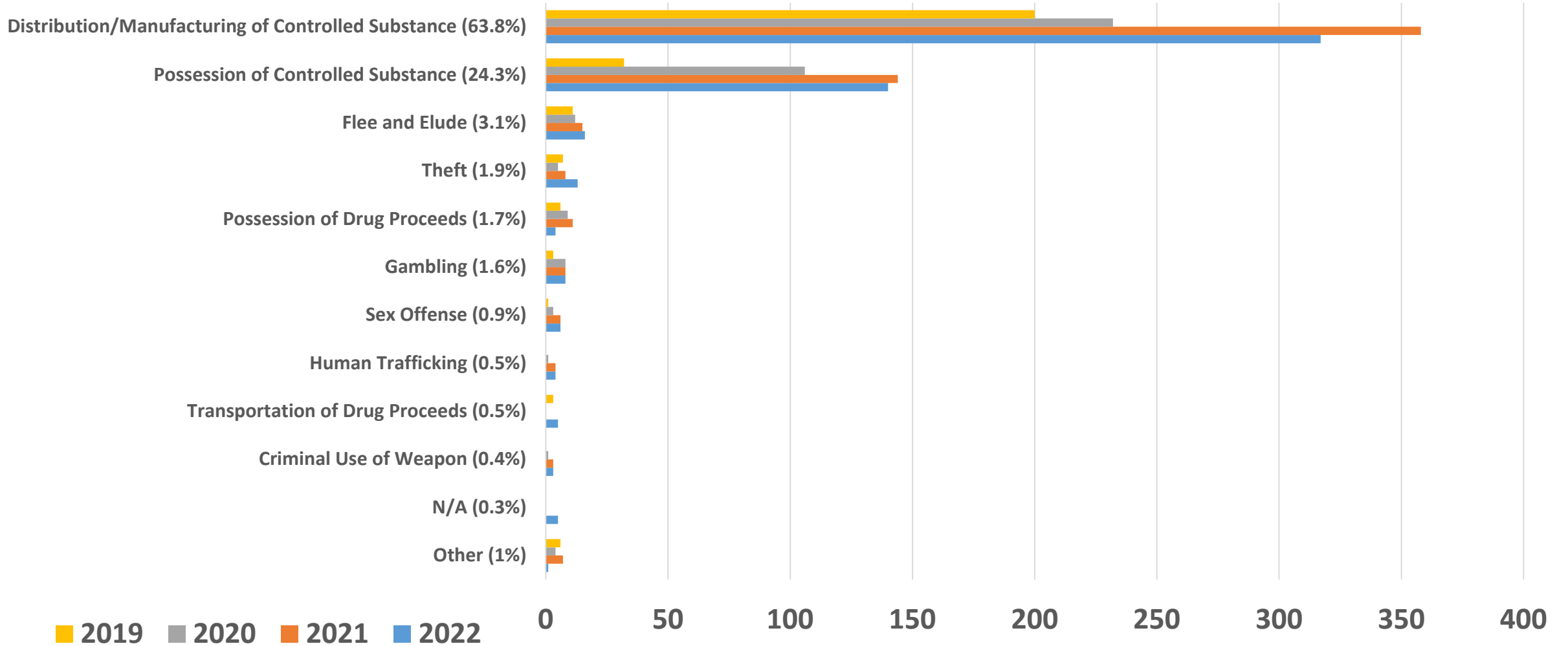
Place of Seizure



Legal Authority under Which Property was Seized

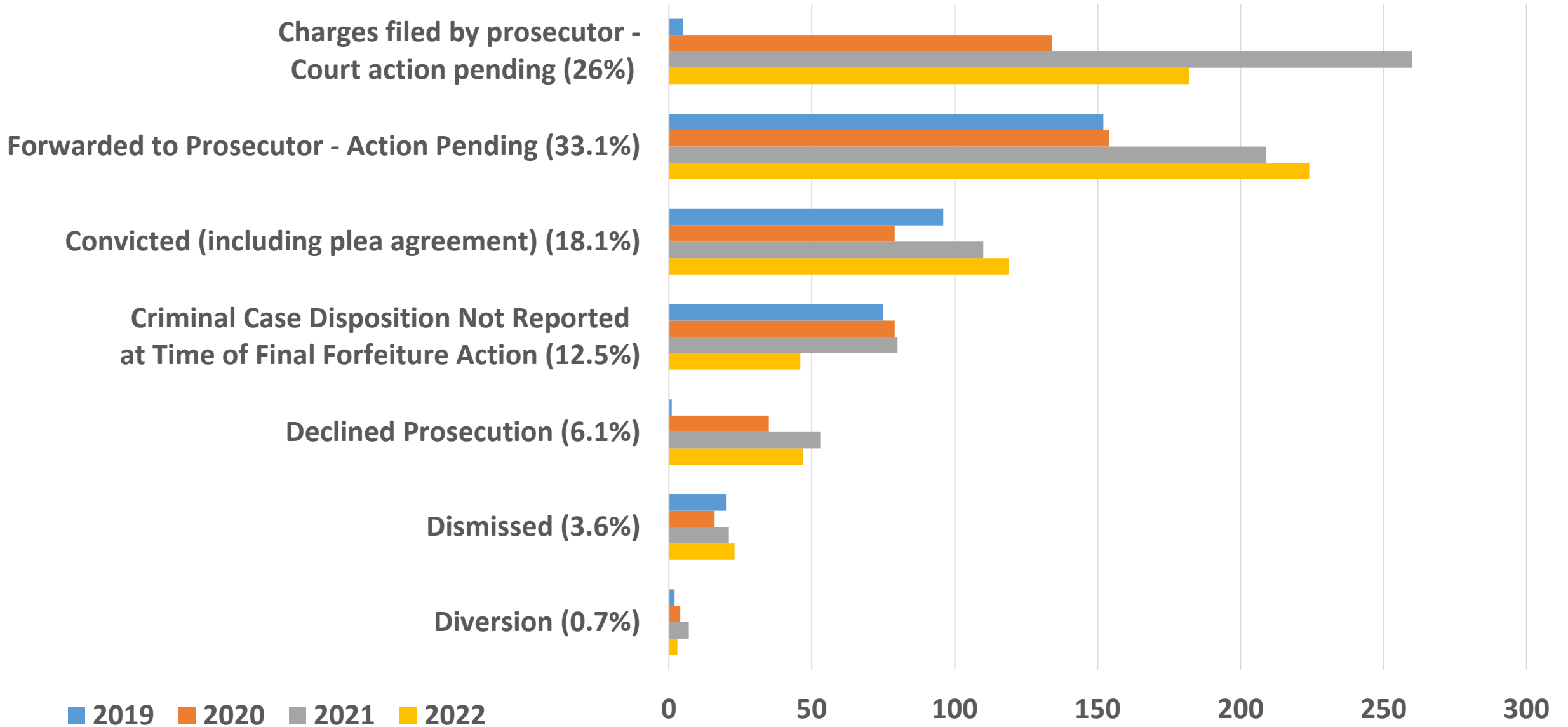

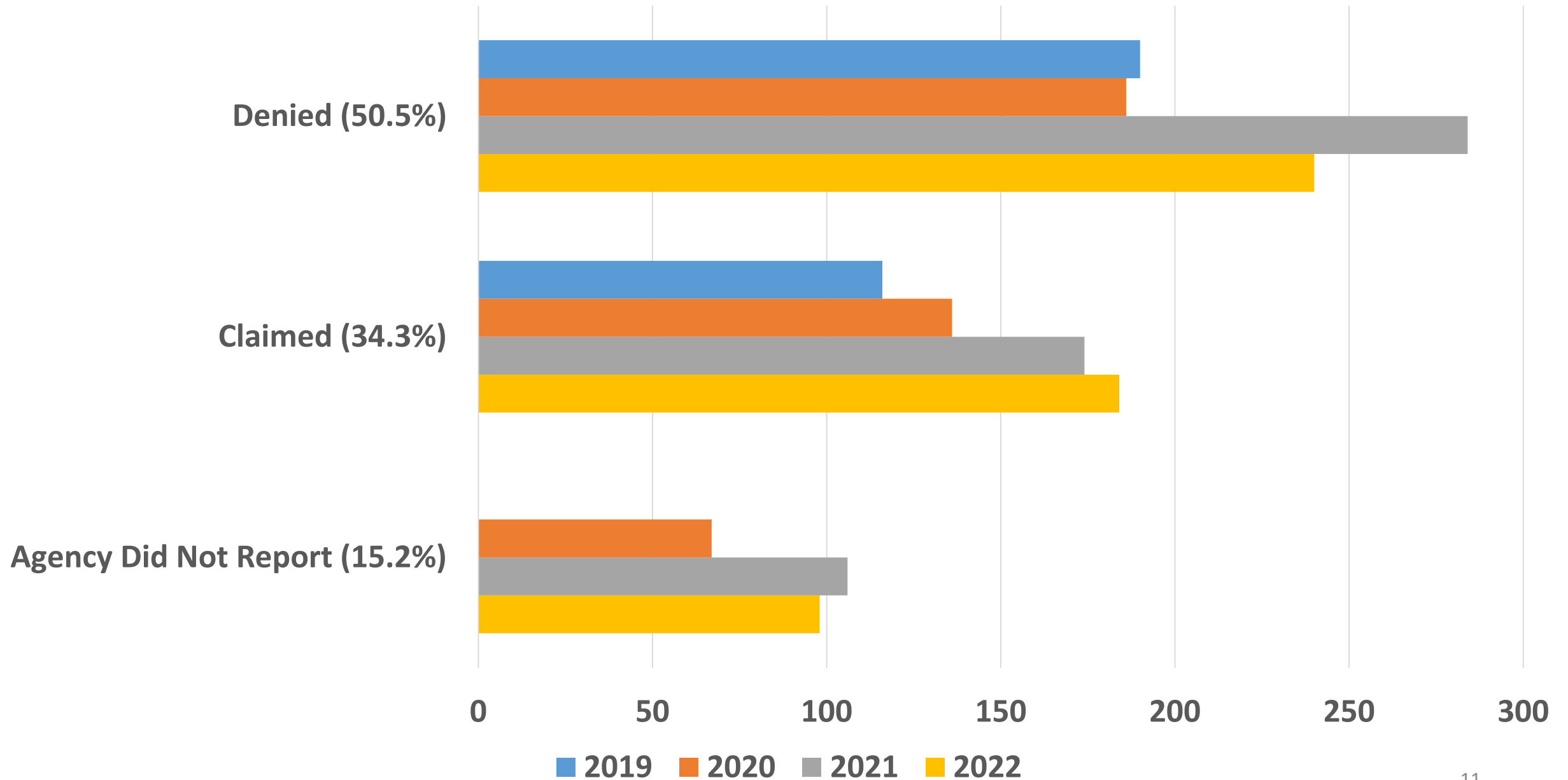

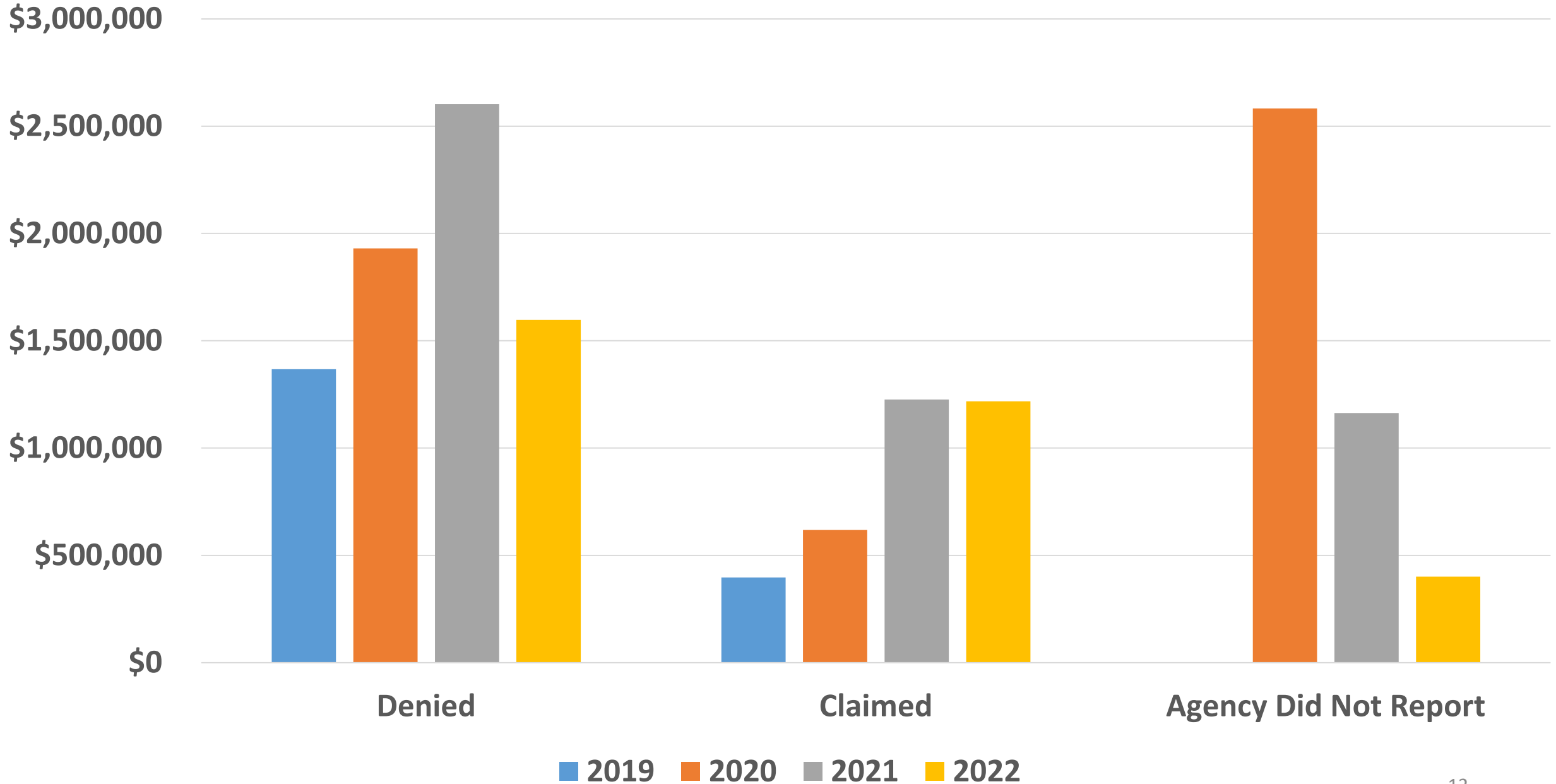
Criminal Case Disposition at Time of Forfeiture Action
