1	AN ACT concerning postsecondary education; relating to the nursing
2	service scholarship program; removing limits on the amount of
3	scholarship awards and the number of scholarships; removing the
4	requirement to obtain a sponsor; modifying the terms and conditions
5	for interest accrual on repayment obligations; abolishing the nursing
6	service scholarship review committee; amending K.S.A. 74-3292, 74-
7	3293, 74-3294, 74-3295, 74-3296, 74-3297 and 74-3298 and repealing
8	the existing sections; also repealing K.S.A. 74-3299.
9	
10	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
11	Section 1. K.S.A. 74-3292 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-
12	3292. As used in this act:
13	(a) "Committee" means the nursing service scholarship review-
14	committee established under K.S.A. 74-3299, and amendments thereto.
15	(b)—"Executive officer" means the chief executive officer of the state
16	board of regents appointed under K.S.A. 74-3203a, and amendments
17	thereto.
18	(c)
19	(1) Any private treatment facility as such term is defined in K.S.A.
20	59-29b46, and amendments thereto;
21	(2) any public treatment facility as such term is defined in K.S.A. 59-
22	29b46, and amendments thereto;
23	(3) any community mental health center organized pursuant to the
24	provisions of K.S.A. 19-4001 through 19-4015, and amendments thereto;
25	and licensed pursuant to K.S.A. 39-2001 et seq., and amendments thereto;
26	(4) any mental health clinic organized pursuant to the provisions of
27	K.S.A. 65-211 through 65-215, and amendments thereto, and licensed-
28	pursuant to K.S.A. 39-2001 et seq., and amendments thereto;
29	(5) any psychiatric hospital, psychiatric residential treatment facility
30	or residential care facility as such terms are defined in K.S.A. 39-2002,-
31	and amendments thereto;
32	(6) any hospital as defined in K.S.A. 65-425, and amendments-
33	thereto, provided: (A) The hospital has a psychiatric unit; and (B) the-
34	scholarship recipient is required to fulfill the nursing service scholarship's
35	employment obligations as an employee in the psychiatric unit of the-

1 hospital; or

2 (7) Osawatomic state hospital, Rainbow mental health facility, Larned
 3 state hospital, Parsons state hospital and training center or the Kansas 4 neurological institute.

(d) "Rural area" means any county of this state other than Douglas,
 Johnson, Sedgwick, Shawnee and Wyandotte counties.

7 (e)(b) "School of nursing" means a school within the state of Kansas 8 which *that* is approved by the state board of nursing to grant an associate 9 degree or a baccalaureate degree in professional nursing or a certificate of 10 completion in practical nursing and is:

11 12 (1) Under the control and supervision of the state board of regents;

(2) a municipal university; or

(3) a not-for-profit independent institution of higher education that
has its main campus or principal place of operation in Kansas, maintains
open enrollment as such term is defined in K.S.A. 74-32,120, and
amendments thereto, and is operated independently and not controlled or
administered by the state or any agency or subdivision thereof.

(f) "Sponsor" means any adult care home licensed under the adult
care home licensure act, any medical care facility licensed under K.S.A.
65-425 et seq., and amendments thereto, any home health agency licensed
under K.S.A. 65-5101 et seq., and amendments thereto, any local health
department as defined in K.S.A. 65-241, and amendments thereto, any
mental health or treatment facility and any state agency which employs
licensed practical nurses or licensed professional nurses.

25 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 74-3293 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-3293. (a) There is hereby established the nursing service scholarship 26 27 program. A scholarship may be awarded under the nursing service 28 scholarship program to any qualified nursing student enrolled in or 29 admitted to a school of nursing in a course of instruction leading to licensure as a licensed professional nurse or licensed practical nurse. A 30 31 nursing student shall not be required to be a resident of Kansas to qualify 32 for a scholarship under the nursing service scholarship program. The 33 number of new scholarships awarded under the nursing service scholarship 34 program in each year shall not exceed 250. Of this number, except as 35 otherwise provided in this section, 100 scholarships shall be awarded to 36 nursing students whose sponsors are located in rural areas and who are-37 enrolled in a course of instruction leading to licensure as a registered-38 professional nurse, 50 scholarships shall be awarded to nursing students 39 enrolled in a course of instruction leading to licensure as a licensed-40 practical nurse and the remaining 100 scholarships shall be awarded to any 41 nursing students who have a sponsor and who are enrolled in a course of 42 instruction leading to licensure as a registered professional nurse. If all scholarships authorized to be awarded under this section to nursing-43

1 students whose sponsors are located in rural areas have not been awarded

2 by a date established by the state board of regents, the scholarships which 3 have not been awarded by that date may be awarded to nursing students 4 who have a sponsor and who are otherwise qualified to be awarded a-5 scholarship under the nursing service scholarship program. The 6 determination of the individuals qualified for such scholarships shall be 7 made by the executive officer-after seeking advice from the committee. 8 Within each scholarship category prescribed by this subsection, 9 Scholarships shall be awarded on a priority basis to qualified applicants-

(1) Whose sponsor is a mental health or treatment facility; and (2) who
 have the greatest financial need for such scholarships. To the extent
 practicable and consistent with the other provisions of this section,
 consideration shall be given to minority applicants.

(b) Scholarships awarded under the nursing service scholarship
program shall be awarded for the length of the course of instruction
leading to licensure as a licensed professional nurse or licensure as a
licensed practical nurse which the student is enrolled in or admitted to
unless otherwise terminated before the expiration of such period of time.
Such scholarships shall provide to a nursing student:

(1) If the nursing student is enrolled in a school of nursing operated
 by a state educational institution, an amount not to exceed 70% of the in state tuition cost of attendance for an academic year at the school of
 nursing in which the nursing student is enrolled; or

(2) if the nursing student is enrolled in a school of nursing notoperated by a state educational institution, the lesser of: (A) An amount not to exceed 70% of the in-state tuition cost of attendance for a year at the school of nursing in which the nursing student is enrolled; or (B) anamount not to exceed 70% of the average amount of the in-state tuition cost of attendance for a year at the schools of nursing operated by the state educational institutions.

(c) The amount of each scholarship shall be established annually by
 the executive officer-and shall be financed equally by the sponsor of the
 nursing student and by the state of Kansas except if:

(1) The sponsor is located in a rural area or is a health care facility
which has less than 100 beds, and is not a mental health or treatmentfacility pursuant to K.S.A. 74-3292(c)(1), (c)(5) or (c)(6), and amendments
thereto, the total amount of the scholarship financed by such sponsor shall
not exceed \$1,000 and the balance of such amount shall be paid by the
state of Kansas; or

40 (2) the sponsor is a mental health or treatment facility pursuant to 41 K.S.A. 74-3292(c)(2), (c)(3), (c)(4) or (c)(7), and amendments thereto, the 42 amount of the scholarship shall be paid by the state and such sponsor shall 43 ret function of the scholarship shall be paid by the state and such sponsor shall

43 not finance any amount of the scholarship.

Sec. 3. K.S.A. 74-3294 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-3294. (a) An applicant for a scholarship under the nursing service scholarship program shall provide to the executive officer, on forms

(1) The name and address of the applicant;

supplied by the executive officer, the following information:

6 (2) the name and address of the school of nursing in which the 7 applicant is enrolled or to which the applicant has been admitted; *and*

8 (3) the name and address of the sponsor of the applicant and a-9 verified copy of the agreement entered into by the applicant and the-10 sponsor in accordance with the provisions of the nursing service-11 scholarship program; and

12 (4)—any additional information—which *that* may be required by the 13 executive officer.

(b) As a condition to awarding a scholarship under the nursing
service scholarship program, the executive officer and the applicant for a
scholarship shall enter into an agreement-which *that* shall require that the
scholarship recipient:

(1) Complete the required course of instruction and, within six
 months after completion, attain licensure with the Kansas state board of
 nursing as a licensed professional nurse or a licensed practical nurse;

21 (2) complete the free application for federal student aid for each 22 academic year for which scholarship funds are awarded under the 23 agreement;

24 (3) within six months after attaining licensure, engage in the full-time practice of nursing, or the equivalent to full-time practice, in-the-25 employment of the sponsor in accordance with the agreement entered into 26 by the scholarship recipient and the sponsor Kansas and continue such 27 full-time practice, or the equivalent to full-time practice, for the total 28 amount of time required under the agreement, which shall be for a period 29 of not less than the length of the course of instruction for which 30 scholarship assistance was provided, or engage in the part-time practice of 31 nursing in the employment of the sponsor in accordance with the 32 agreement entered into by the scholarship recipient and the sponsor-33 Kansas and continue such part-time practice for the total amount of time 34 required under the agreement, which shall be for a period of time that is 35 equivalent to full time, as determined by the state board of regents, 36 37 multiplied by the length of the course of instruction for which scholarship 38 assistance was provided;

39 (3)(4) commence the full-time practice of nursing, or the equivalent
40 to full-time practice, or the part-time practice of nursing, within six months
41 after registration in accordance with the agreement entered into by the
42 scholarship recipient and the sponsor, continue such practice for the total
43 amount of time required under the agreement, and comply with such other

1 terms and conditions as may be specified by such agreement;

2 (4)(5) maintain records and make reports to the executive officer as 3 may be required by the executive officer to document the satisfaction of 4 the obligations under the nursing service scholarship program and under 5 agreements entered into with the sponsor pursuant thereto; and

6 (5)(6) upon failure to satisfy-an agreement to engage in the full-time 7 practice of nursing, or the equivalent to full-time practice, or the part-time 8 practice of nursing, for the required period of time under any such-9 agreement, the requirements of the agreement, to repay to the state-and to 10 the sponsor the amounts as provided in K.S.A. 74-3295, and amendments 11 thereto.

(c) Upon the awarding of a scholarship under the nursing service
 scholarship program, the sponsor shall pay to the executive officer the
 amount of such scholarship to be financed by the sponsor, if any. Each
 such amount shall be deposited in the nursing service scholarship program
 fund in accordance with K.S.A. 74-3298, and amendments thereto.

17 (d) The sponsorship by a scholarship recipient may be transferredfrom one sponsor to another upon the agreement of the original sponsor, 18 19 the scholarship recipient and the sponsor to which the sponsorship is to be transferred. The terms, conditions and obligations of the transferred-20 21 agreement shall be substantially similar to the terms, conditions and 22 obligations of the original agreement. No sponsorship shall be transferred 23 unless the agreement transferring such sponsorship provides for service in 24 a rural area or in a mental health or treatment facility and is approved by 25 the executive officer as consistent with the provisions of the nursingservice scholarship program and as consistent with any rules and 26 regulations relating thereto adopted by the state board of regents in-27 28 accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 74-3297, and amendments-29 thereto.

30 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 74-3295 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-3295. (a) Except as provided in K.S.A. 74-3296, and amendments thereto, 31 upon the failure of any person to satisfy the obligation under any 32 agreement entered into pursuant to the nursing service scholarship 33 program, such person shall pay to the executive officer an amount equal to 34 35 the total amount of money received by such person pursuant to such 36 agreement-which that was financed by the state of Kansas plus accrued 37 interest at a rate-which is equivalent to the interest rate applicable to loans 38 made under the federal PLUS program at the time such person first entered 39 into an agreement plus five percentage points and shall pay to the sponsor 40 an amount equal to the total amount of money received by such personpursuant to such agreement which was financed by the sponsor plus-41 accrued interest at a rate which is equivalent to the interest rate applicable 42 43 to loans made under the federal PLUS program at the time such person-

first entered into an agreement plus five percentage points of 5% per 1 annum. Interest shall begin to accrue on the date of the action or 2 circumstances that cause such person to fail to satisfy the obligations of 3 such agreement, as determined by the executive officer based upon the 4 circumstances of each individual case. Installment payments of any such 5 6 amounts may be made in accordance with the provisions of agreements 7 entered into by the scholarship recipient and the sponsor or if no such-8 provisions exist in such agreements, in accordance with rules and 9 regulations of the state board of regents, except that. Such installment payments shall commence six months after the date-of the action or-10 eircumstances that eause the failure of the person to satisfy the obligations 11 12 of such agreements, as determined by the executive officer based upon the circumstances of each individual case on which interest begins to accrue. 13 14 Amounts paid under this section to the executive officer shall be deposited 15 in the nursing service scholarship repayment fund in accordance with 16 K.S.A. 74-3298, and amendments thereto.

17 (b) The state board of regents is authorized to turn any repayment 18 account arising under the nursing service scholarship program over to a 19 designated loan servicer or collection agency, the state not being involved 20 other than to receive payments from the loan servicer or collection agency 21 at the interest rate prescribed under this section.

Sec. 5. K.S.A. 74-3296 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-3296. (a) (1) Except as otherwise specified in the agreement with the sponsor, An obligation under any agreement entered into under the nursing student scholarship program shall be postponed:

(1)(A) During any required period of active military service;

27 (2)(B) during any period of service as a part of volunteers in service 28 to America (VISTA);

(3)(C) during any period of service in the peace corps;

30 (4)(D) during any period of service commitment to the United States 31 public health service;

32 (5)(E) during any period of religious missionary work conducted by 33 an organization exempt from tax under section 501(c)(3) of the federal 34 internal revenue code as in effect on December 31, 2000 July 1, 2024;

(6) (*F*) during any period of time the person obligated is unable because of temporary medical disability to practice nursing;

37 (7)(G) during any period of time the person obligated is enrolled and 38 actively engaged on a full-time basis in a course of study leading to a 39 degree in the field of nursing-which *that* is higher than that attained 40 formerly by the person obligated;

41 (8)(H) during any period of time *that* the person obligated is on job-42 protected leave under the federal family and medical leave act of 1993; or

43 (9)(I) during any period of time the state board of regents determines

that the person obligated is unable because of special circumstances to
 practice nursing.

3 (2) Except for-clauses (6), (8) and (9) paragraphs (1)(F), (1)(H) and 4 (1)(I), an obligation under any agreement entered into as provided in the 5 nursing service scholarship program shall not be postponed more than five 6 years from the time the obligation was to have been commenced under any 7 such agreement.

8 (3) An obligation under any agreement entered into as provided in the
 9 nursing service scholarship program shall be postponed under clause (6)
 10 paragraph (1)(F) during the period of time the medical disability exists.

11 (4) An obligation under any agreement entered into as provided in the 12 nursing service scholarship program shall be postponed under elause (8) 13 paragraph (1)(H) during the period of time the person obligated remains 14 on FMLA leave.

(5) An obligation under any agreement entered into as provided in the
 nursing service scholarship program shall be postponed under elause (9)
 paragraph (1)(1) during the period of time the state board of regents
 determines that the special circumstances exist.

19 (6) The state board of regents shall adopt rules and regulations prescribing criteria or guidelines for determination of the existence of 20 21 special circumstances causing an inability to satisfy an obligation under 22 any agreement entered into as provided in the nursing service scholarship 23 program, and shall determine the documentation required to prove the 24 existence of such circumstances. Except for clauses (1), (6), (8) and (9), an 25 obligation under any agreement entered into as provided in the nursingservice scholarship program shall not be postponed unless the-26 postponement is approved by the sponsor or is otherwise provided for in 27 the agreement with the sponsor. 28

(b) An obligation under any agreement entered into as provided in thenursing service scholarship program shall be satisfied:

31 (1) If the obligation has been completed in accordance with the32 agreement;

33

(2) if the person obligated dies;

34 (3) if, because of permanent physical disability, the person obligated35 is unable to satisfy the obligation;

36 (4) if the person obligated fails to satisfy the requirements for
37 graduation from the school of nursing after making the best effort possible
38 to do so; *and*

(5) if the person obligated fails to satisfy all requirements for a permanent license to practice nursing in Kansas or has been denied a license after applying for a license and making the best effort possible to obtain such license; (6) if, because of bankruptey, loss of licensure or certification or other failure in the operations of the sponsor, the sponsor. cannot or will not employ the person obligated; or (7) if the sponsor
 releases the person obligated from employment with the sponsor and the
 person obligated otherwise completes the terms, conditions and obligations

4 of the agreement by engaging in the practice of nursing in Kansas.

5 K.S.A. 74-3297 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-Sec. 6. 6 3297. (a) The state board of regents, after consultation with the committee, 7 may adopt rules and regulations establishing minimum terms, conditions 8 and obligations which shall be incorporated into the provisions of any-9 agreement entered into between a sponsor and the recipient of ascholarship under the nursing service scholarship program. The terms,-10 conditions and obligations shall be consistent with the provisions of law 11 12 relating to the nursing service scholarship program. The terms, conditions and obligations so established shall include, but not be limited to, the-13 14 terms of eligibility for financial assistance under the nursing service-15 scholarship program, the amount of financial assistance to be offered, the 16 length of employment with the sponsor required as a condition to the-17 receipt of such financial assistance, the circumstances under which the-18 employment obligation may be discharged or forgiven, the amount of 19 money required to be repaid because of failure to satisfy the obligations under an agreement and the method of repayment and such other-20 21 additional provisions as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of 22 the nursing service scholarship program. The state board of regents, after 23 consultation with the committee, shall adopt rules and regulations as 24 necessary to administer the nursing service scholarship program.

(b) The state board of regents shall provide an annual written report
 on the nursing service scholarship program to the senate and house
 committees on education.

28 Sec. 7. K.S.A. 74-3298 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-29 3298. (a) There is hereby created in the state treasury the nursing service scholarship program fund. The executive officer shall remit all moneys 30 31 received from sponsors, which are paid under K.S.A. 74-3294, and 32 amendments thereto, pursuant to scholarship awards, or from a school of 33 nursing, which that are paid because of nonattendance or discontinued 34 attendance by scholarship recipients, to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon 35 36 receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire 37 amount in the state treasury to the credit of the nursing service scholarship 38 program fund. All expenditures from the nursing service scholarship 39 program fund shall be for scholarships awarded under the nursing service 40 scholarship program-or refunds to sponsors and shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of 41 accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the 42 43 executive officer or by a person designated by the executive officer.

1 (b) The nursing student scholarship discontinued attendance fund is 2 hereby abolished. On the effective date of this act, the director of accounts 3 and reports shall transfer all moneys remaining in the nursing student 4 scholarship discontinued attendance fund to the nursing service 5 scholarship program fund.

6 (c) There is hereby created in the state treasury the nursing service 7 scholarship repayment fund. The executive officer shall remit all moneys 8 received for amounts paid under K.S.A. 74-3295, and amendments thereto, 9 to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance the state 10 11 treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit 12 of the nursing service scholarship repayment fund. All expenditures from the nursing service scholarship repayment fund shall be for scholarships 13 14 awarded under the nursing service scholarship program and shall be made 15 in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of 16 accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the executive officer or by a person designated by the executive officer. 17

18 Sec. 8. K.S.A. 74-3292, 74-3293, 74-3294, 74-3295, 74-3296, 74-19 3297, 74-3298 and 74-3299 are hereby repealed.

20 Sec. 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 21 publication in the Kansas register.
