AN ACT concerning health and healthcare; relating to nonopioid alternatives for the treatment of pain; requiring the department of health and environment to develop and publish educational information regarding the use of nonopioids.

 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The department of health and environment shall develop and publish on its website an educational pamphlet regarding the use of nonopioid alternatives for the treatment of acute, subacute and chronic pain. The information in the pamphlet shall conform to the most current clinical practice guidelines for prescribing opioids for pain issued by the United States centers for disease control and prevention and may be updated as needed. The information in the pamphlet shall include, but not be limited to:

- (1) Information on available nonopioid alternatives for the treatment of pain, including pharmacological and nonpharmacological treatments; and
- (2) the advantages and disadvantages of the use of nonopioid alternatives.
- (b) Before January 1, 2025, and every two years thereafter, the department of health and environment shall distribute the most updated version of the educational pamphlet, required by subsection (a) to local public health agencies in Kansas and associations representing federally qualified health centers, rural health clinics, community mental health centers and certified community behavioral health clinics in Kansas.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
