AN ACT concerning health and healthcare; relating to certain definitions; providing that a fertilized human ovum or embryo existing outside of the uterus of a human body shall not be considered an unborn child or human being.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) A fertilized human ovum or human embryo that exists in any form outside the uterus of a human body shall not be considered an unborn child, a minor child, a natural person or any other term that connotes a human being for any purpose under the laws of this state.

- (b) As used in this section, "embryo" means a cell or group of cells containing a diploid complement of chromosomes or group of such cells, not a gamete or gametes, that has the potential to develop into a live born human being if transferred into the body of an individual under conditions in which gestation may be reasonably expected to occur.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
