SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2290 by House Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2290 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2290 would require expenditures by a local school board for engaging or supporting any litigation regarding school finance to be approved by a majority of the qualified electors of a district.

According to the Kansas Department of Education, enactment of HB 2290 would have no effect on state financial aid to schools. Expenditures at the local school district level could be reduced if electors not approve a resolution authorizing school finance litigation.
