**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2555 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2555 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2555 would amend the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Act to include in the definition of "conviction" deferred judgement agreements entered into on or after July 1, 1995, for a felony, and any deferred judgement for a misdemeanor offense that the Kansas Commission on Peace Officers Standards and Training determines reflects on the honesty, trustworthiness or competence of an applicant.

According to the Kansas Commission on Peace Officers Standards and Training, passage of HB 2555 would have no fiscal effect.
