SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 282 by Senate Committee on Public Health and Welfare

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 282 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

The bill amends the state's Uniform Controlled Substances Act by adding and updating drugs contained in Schedules II and III. The bill also amends Schedule I which includes drugs that are illegal to possess.

SB 282 may have an effect on local and state prosecutors, law enforcement, and Department of Corrections. Enactment of the bill could potentially result in additional arrests, court time, prison time, and lab testing. The bill would have no fiscal effect on the Board of Pharmacy. There could also be an increase in revenues for criminal fines.
