
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2679 by House Committee on Energy, Utilities and Telecommunications

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2679 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2679 would amend the Kansas Energy Efficiency Investments Act to add definitions for “fuel switching,” “interruptible or curtailable rate,” “lost margin revenue,” and “total utility resource cost test.” The bill also modifies existing definitions for “demand-side program” and “energy efficiency program.” The bill would modify the evaluation process currently used by the Kansas Corporation Commission to evaluate energy efficiency programs.

The Kansas Corporation Commission indicates that enactment of HB 2679 would have no fiscal effect on agency operations.
