

**SENATE BILL No. 406**

1 AN ACT creating the Sedgwick county charter commission.

2  
3 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

4 Section 1. (a) A charter commission for Sedgwick county established  
5 pursuant to K.S.A. 19-2681, and amendments thereto, shall consist of 25  
6 members and shall be appointed as follows:

7 (1) (A) Three members shall be appointed by the members of the  
8 senate of the state of Kansas who are residents of Sedgwick county; and

9 (B) three members shall be appointed by the members of the house of  
10 representatives of the state of Kansas who are residents of Sedgwick  
11 county;

12 Each member appointed pursuant to this subsection (1) shall reside in a  
13 different senatorial district;

14 (2) two members shall be appointed by the governing body of the  
15 Sedgwick county republican central committee;

16 (3) two members shall be appointed by the governing body of the  
17 Sedgwick county democratic central committee;

18 (4) eight members shall be appointed by the Sedgwick county board  
19 of county commissioners. Of such members, one member shall be  
20 appointed from each county commissioner district and the remaining shall  
21 represent the county at large;

22 (5) two members shall be appointed by the Wichita regional chamber  
23 of commerce;

24 (6) two members shall be appointed by the Sedgwick county  
25 association of cities. Such members shall be mayors or their designees of  
26 cities located in Sedgwick county;

27 (7) one member shall be appointed by the city of Wichita and shall be  
28 the mayor or the mayor's designee; and

29 (8) two members shall be appointed by the metropolitan area  
30 planning commission and such members shall be residents of the  
31 unincorporated area of Sedgwick county.

32 (b) Members shall be appointed within 21 days after the adoption of  
33 the resolution establishing the charter commission.

34 (c) No person holding an elective state or county office shall serve on  
35 the charter commission.

36 (d) Any vacancy on the charter commission shall be filled by the

- 1 appointing authority which made the original appointment.
- 2       Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
- 3 publication in the statute book.
