
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2220 by House Committee on Commerce, Labor and Economic Development

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2220 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2220 would give preference to persons with disabilities for employment and promotion in Kansas state government if qualified, with or without reasonable accommodation, to meet the performance standards of the position. Job opening notices and application forms would need to state that the position is subject to the disability preference. An applicant would need to provide documentation of a disability and state agencies would be required to offer an interview to the applicant.

The Department of Administration indicates enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect on Department operations or state employment procedures.
