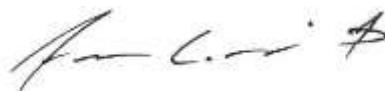
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2275 by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2275 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2275 would require the Secretary of Corrections to develop guidance for parole officers that includes intervention responses to behavior that would constitute a violation of parole or post release supervision and incentive responses to compliant behavior and pro-social achievements.

The Department of Corrections indicates that enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect.
