
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2302 by House Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2302 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, a parent or guardian is required to give written consent before any test, questionnaire, survey or examination containing any questions about a student's, parent or legal guardian's personal beliefs on issues including sex, family life, morality or religion can be administered. HB 2302 would require the parent or guardian to be provided a copy of the test, questionnaire, survey, or examination prior to giving consent.

Enactment of HB 2302 would have no fiscal effect.
