SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2448 by House Committee on Appropriations


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2448 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2448 would permit the Secretary of the Department for Children and Families to license a family foster home when a person:

1. Was adjudicated as a juvenile offender;
2. Had committed a felony that is a crime against persons as described in Articles 34, 35, or 36 of Chapter 21 of the *Kansas Statutes Annotated*;
3. Was a child in the custody of the Department for Children and Families and placed in the family foster home;
4. Is 18 years of age or older;
5. Maintains residency at the family foster home; or
6. Has been legally adopted by any person residing in the family foster home.

The Department for Children and Families indicates that HB 2448 would have no fiscal effect on the agency's operations.
