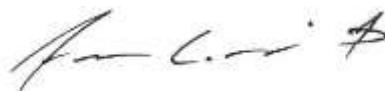
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2580 by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2580 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2580 would allow a law enforcement officer serving in the Kansas Legislature to receive a reduction of ten of the 40 required hours of continuing law enforcement education or training for each compliance period in which the officer serves in the Kansas Legislature.

The Kansas Commission on Peace Officers' Standards and Training indicates that enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect.
